

## BIA opens new downtown office Tuesday afternoon

Local and regional officials were present for the official opening of the new Acton BIA (Business Improvement Area) office on Tuesday afternoon, October 15. The renovated office is located in the former Déjà Vu consignment shop at 16 Mill St. E.

Refreshments were served in the office after the official ribbon cutting which included Regional Chairman Joyce Savoline, Mayor Kathy Gastle, Miss Acton Fall Fair Joanne Haughie, and 1st runner up Rebecca Burtney, as well as BIA chairman John McNable, directors Tracy Mitchell and Monica Galway and co-ordinator Josey Bonnette.

After years of using a donated office at the old Hide House, space now needed for that growing business, the BIA board

of managers voted to relocate to the downtown area.

Part-time BIA co-ordinator Josey Bonnette has been contracted to fill a new full time position of co-ordinator/ maintenance person as of January 1.

Bonnette said she hopes the move will give the BIA more presence downtown and become more accessible to it 84 members.

Alexanian Flooring donated a new floor and labour to the offices.

The BIA is a geographic area in downtown Acton whose members are property owners and business people within the area.

The elected board of management has a two fold mandate to improve, beautify and maintain land and buildings within the BIA, and to promote the downtown as a business and shopping area.
