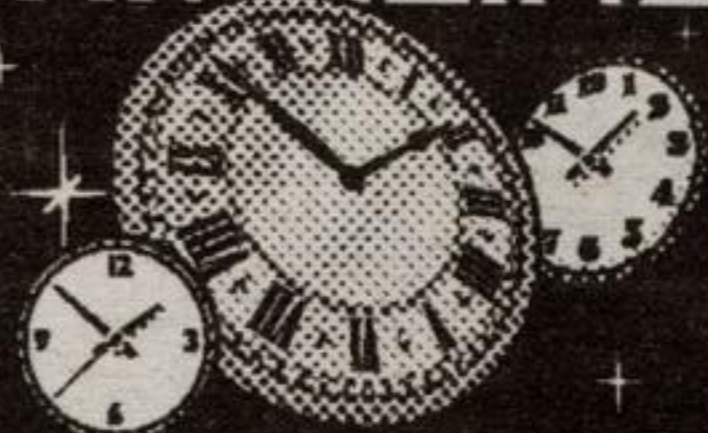

• ALBERT SCHWEITZER WINS THE NOBEL PEACE PRIZE FOR HIS HUMANITARIAN WORK IN AFRICA.



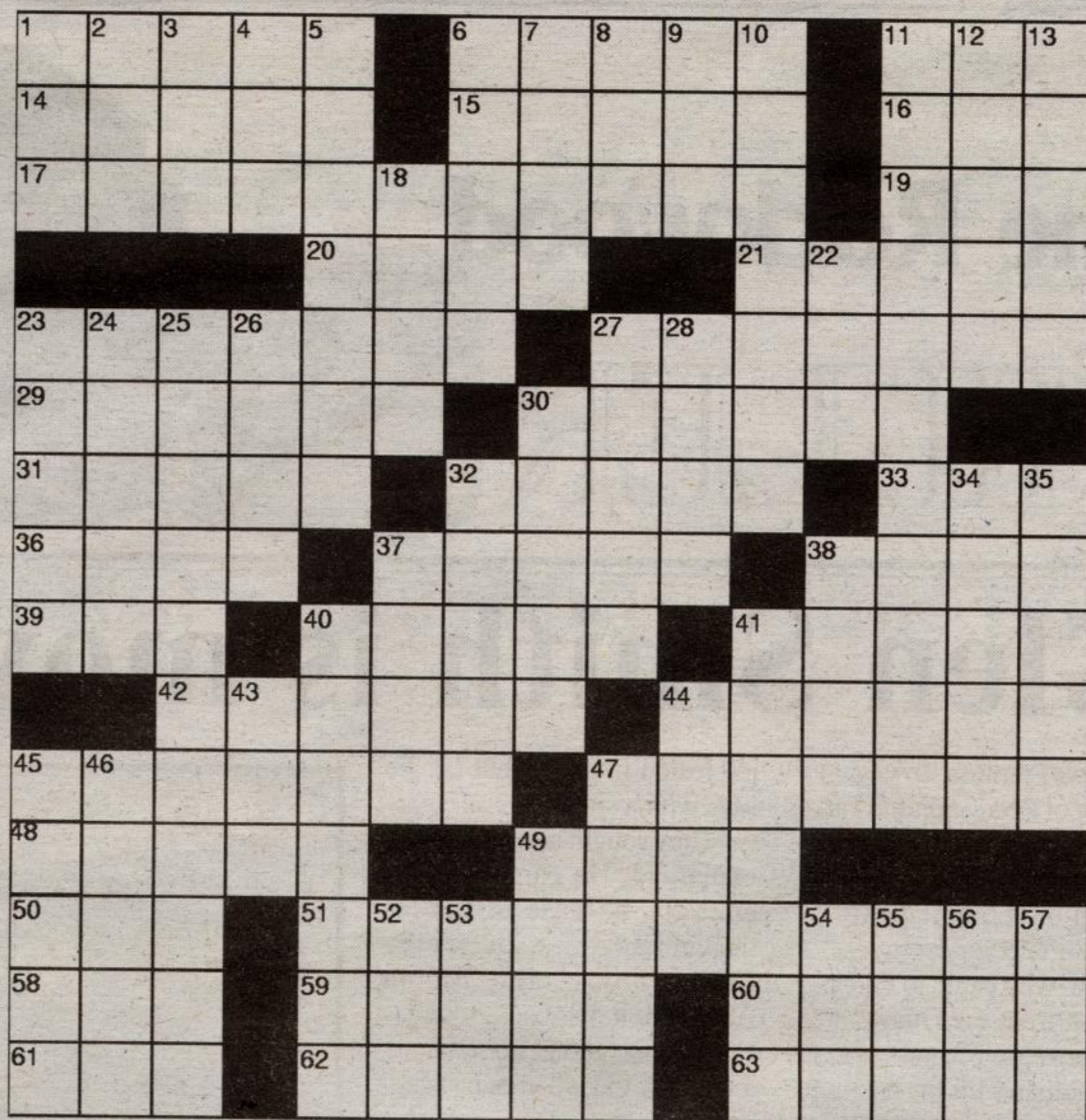
