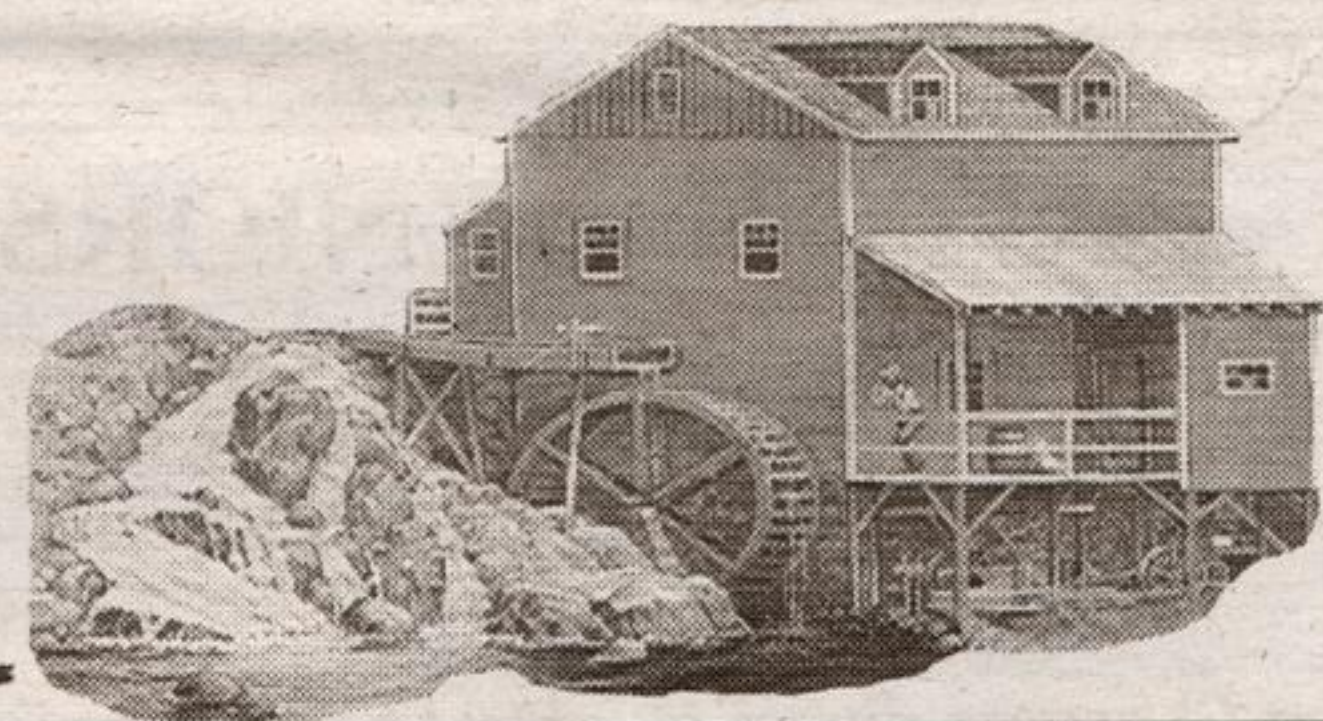

Consumers get cheques

Rockwood's total rebates, credits total over \$85,000

Like other local distribution companies across the province, Wellington Electric Distribution Company began distributing Ontario-legislated \$75 rebate cheques to approximately 1,045 of its 1,200 residential and business customers.

The cheques represent interim rebates on the amount customers have paid for electricity over the frozen price of 4.3 cents a kilowatt-hour since May 1.

In legislation passed December 9, the provincial government authorized the price freeze and the rebate payments to help consumers cope with electricity commodity prices that soared after the market was opened to competition on May 1. The 4.3-cent cap represents the price of electricity that existed before the market was

opened to competition.

"We are pleased that we have been able to get the rebates out to our customers quickly and efficiently within the time frame set out by the Ontario government," said Jim MacKenzie, Company President.

Most residential and small business customers will receive a rebate cheque, including those who signed fixed rate contracts with independent energy retailers. If the interim payment does not cover the full amount owed, the remainder will show up as a credit on the account at a later date.

The cheques have been sent to eligible households and businesses that were customers on November 25. The eligibility date was set by provincial legislation. Under the rules

drafted by the Government about 112 customers who participate in Wellington Electric Distribution's Budget Payment Plan may receive a rebate as a credit on their account, instead of a cheque.

MacKenzie said the total value of all rebates and credits in Rockwood will be approximately \$85,000. "We are continuing to monitor the situation closely and will keep our customers informed as further details on Ontario's electricity market become available," he said.

Wellington Electric Distribution is Rockwood's electricity distribution company which delivers electricity, maintains the transformers and lines to homes and businesses, ensures the system meets Rockwood's growing
