Passing on right... **Continued from Page 18** the right if the roadway is designated for one-way traffic only.

When is it illegal to pass on the right?

Section 150 (2) states it is illegal to pass or overtake another vehicle on the right if you have to drive on an unpaved (gravel or dirt) shoulder of the

roadway to do so. The only vehicles permitted to use an unpaved shoulder are emergency vehicles, which would include: Police, Fire, Ambulance and other Ministry emergency vehicles.

The minimum penalty for illegal passing is \$110 and three demerit points.




