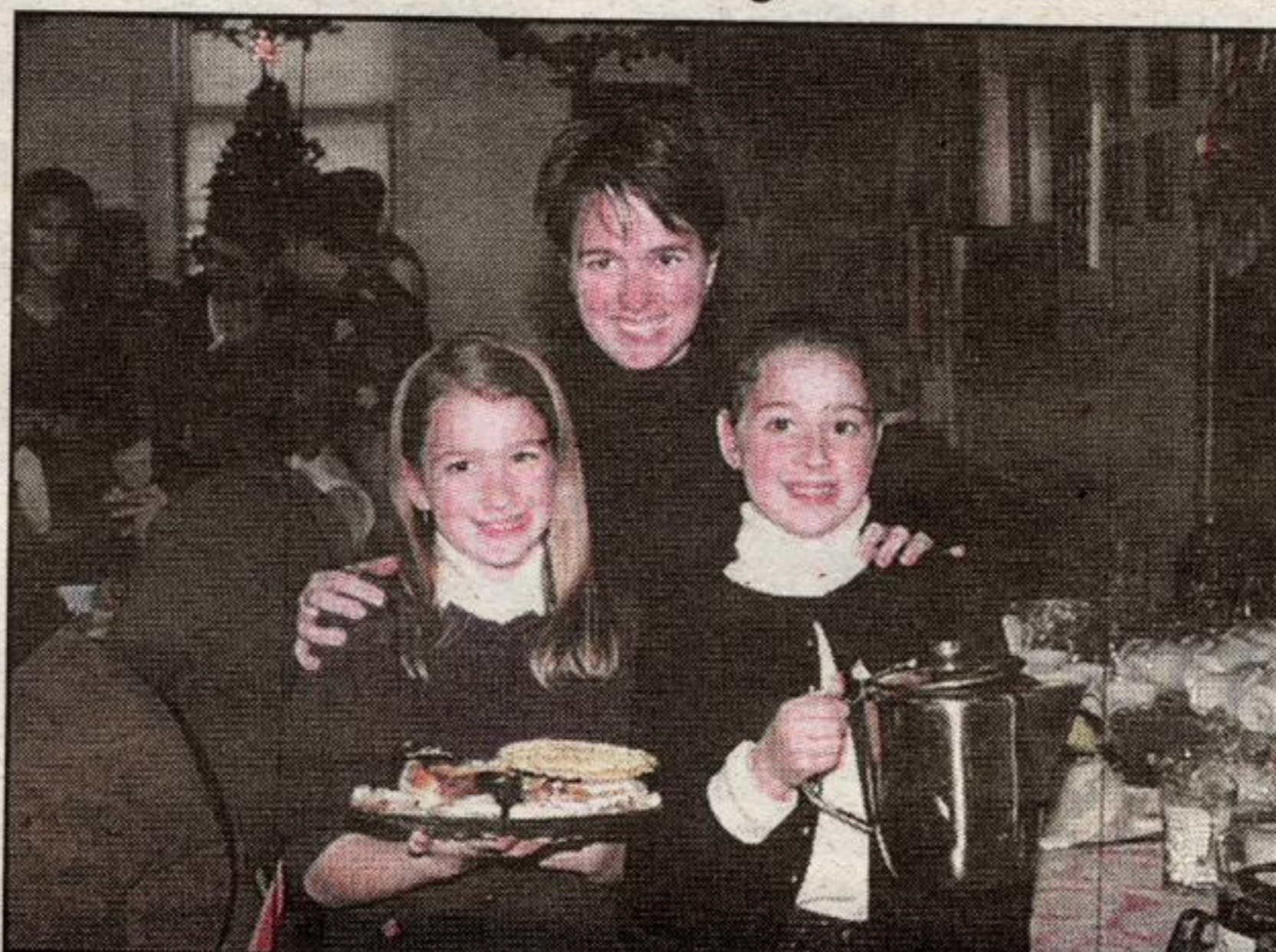
Betty Green and her committee have planned some super trips before Christmas:
