Take precautions to avoid Yule fires-Fire Chief

Christmas is the most treasured time of the year, says Halton Hills Fire Chief Bob Meads, but unfortunately it can be marked by tragedy if precautions are not taken against accidental fires. The Christmas season is when the number of deaths caused by accidental household fires

are at their highest and one of the major reasons for a significant increase is the Christmas tree, says Meads. "Fire is one of the greatest threats to your family and home," says Meads. "People do not realize the emotional toll a fire can take, leaving you in emotional turmoil for life." Chief Meads adds "You need to take extra precaution to minimize the risks of fire and in the event a fire does occur, know how to react." Safety tips for the care of the family Christmas tree, offered by the fire chief include:

1. Leave the tree outside until you're ready to put it up and decorate.

2. Cut 2-3" off the base of the tree before placing into stand.

3. Check and add water on a daily basis.

4. Keep the tree away from

floor heaters, fireplaces and other sources of heat

5. Use CSA-listed lights.

6. Use miniature lights which have cool burning bulbs.

7. Unplug the Christmas lights when leaving the home or going to bed.

8. Make sure the bulbs are securely installed in the sockets.

9. Closely inspect the lights before using them and discard any worn ones.

10. Avoid overloading wall receptacles and extension cords.
