continued from page 1 Health Professional Recruitment Tour at Queen's University.

In Acton, the doctors met with physicians at the Acton Medical Centre and toured the town before going to Milton.

Asked what it will take to find new general practitioners for Acton, Mayor Rick Bonnette, who has championed the search, said they might have to offer special incentives or inducements to attract doctors to Acton.

"It's something that


we're going to have to address," Bonnette said on Monday, adding, "I'm not going to paint a dark cloud above Acton, because right now, Acton is one of the most positive places to go - that last small town in the GTA."

Bonnette said the Rerecruitment gional program has "put Acton on the map" with physicians, bringing at least 10 doctors on tours through the area.

Halton Hills has been designated as an underserviced area for family physicians by the province,

and based on the accepted physician-to-patient ratio of one family physician to 1,380 patients, Acton needs at least nine more family doctors and Halton needs 45 additional general practitioners.

Like Halton Hills, Milton was also designated as an under-serviced area, but in the past two years attracted enough physicians to work itself off that list. Because of the recent growth in Milton, it has filed another application for the underserviced designation.


