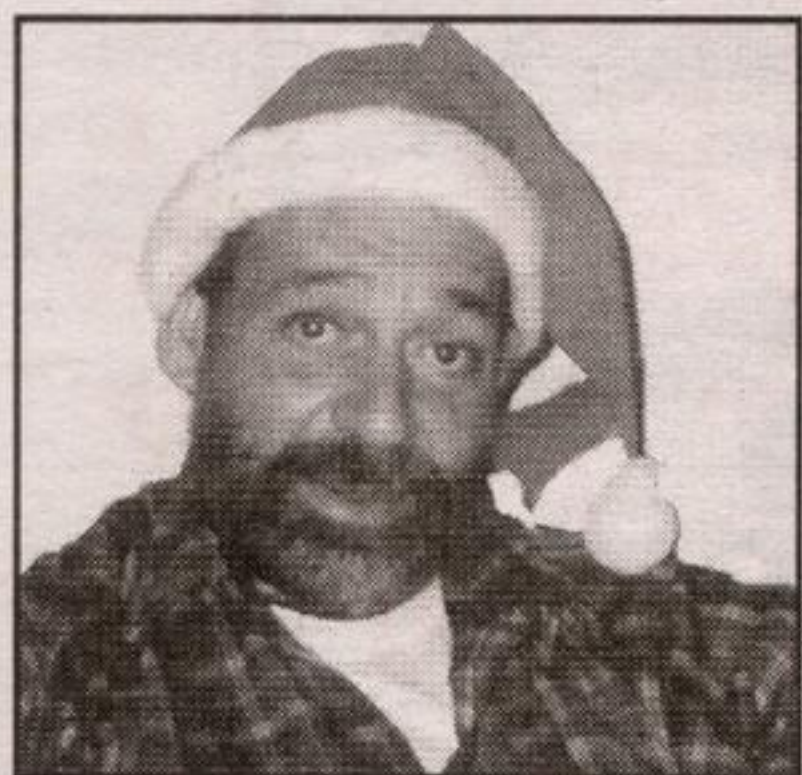

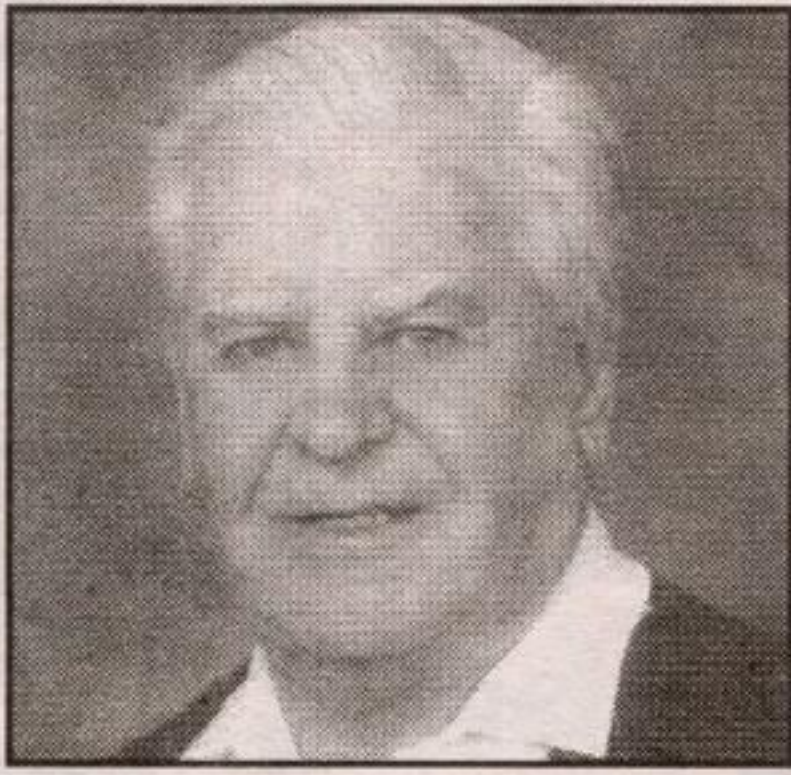


BUNA: Peter Paul

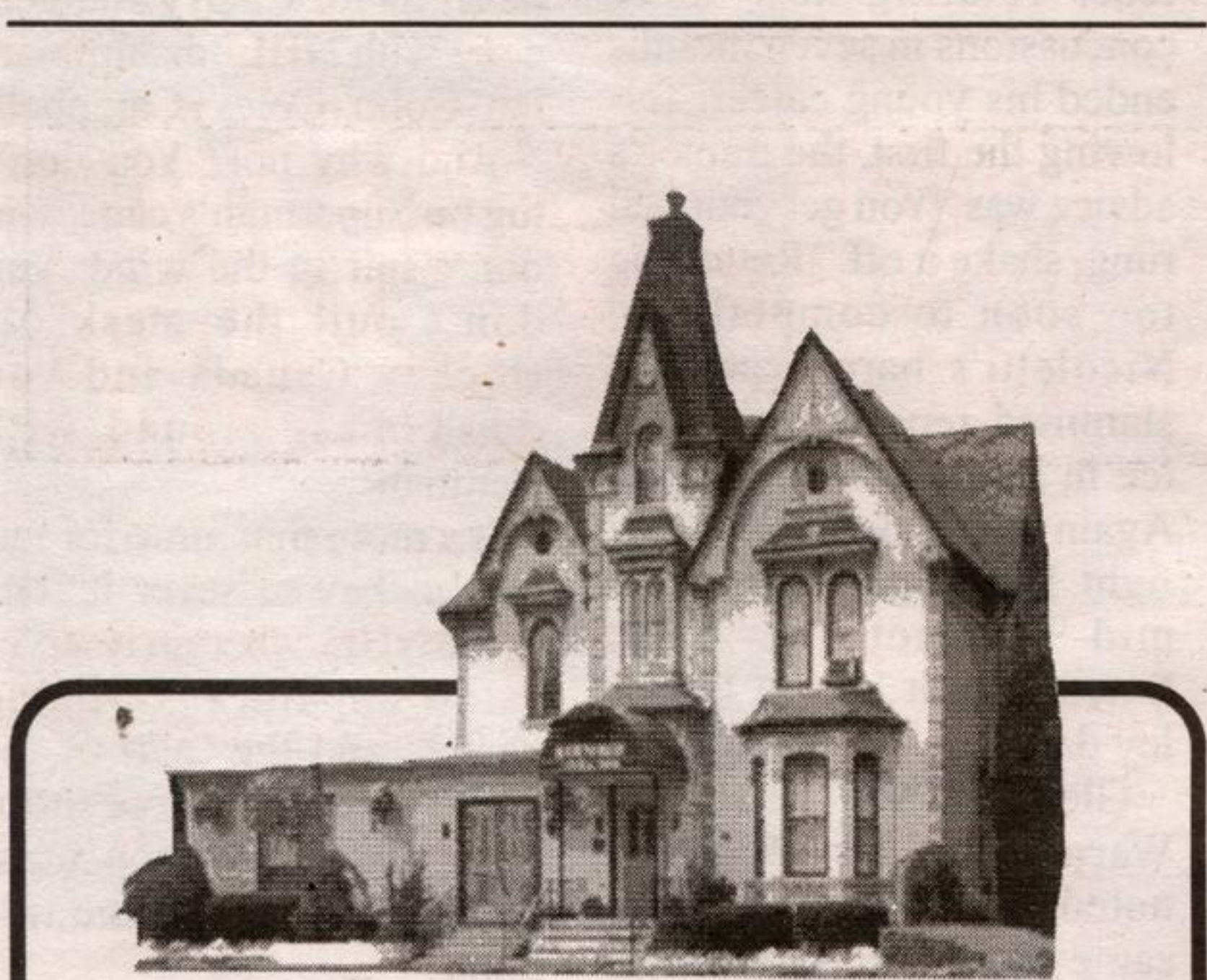
