Halton Hills named Green St. community

Halton Hills is one of 36 Canadian municipalities to be named one of Green Street Canada Communities 2004.

Green Streets Canada is the country's self-described largest municipal urban forestry program. It has assigned a \$20,000 grant for the participation of the Georgetown Agricultural Society in part of Earth Day events planting trees on road allowances.

Green Streets' objective

is to improve urban forests and provide people with a greater appreciation of the role trees play in the environment and their overall quality of life. The total value of projects in 2004 is \$1,335,902.

Over 280 Canadian communities have been "greened" under the program since 1994. Over \$10 million in total funding has been committed to municipal trees and forests.

Tom Chudleigh selected for Ont. Agricultural Hall of Fame

Apple farmer Tom Chudleigh is being recognized for his leadership, innovation and entrepreneurship in the advancement of agriculture in Ontario by his selection into the Ontario Agricultural Hall of Fame.

Chudleigh is one of five Ontarions selected for the honour. They will be inducted in the Hall of Fame Gallery at Country Heritage Park, Milton, on Sunday, June 13.

Along with wife Carol and their sons, Tom Chudleigh has led the fruit industry in the province in apple production as well as pioneering direct

farm marketing from Chudleigh's Apple Farm on Regional Road 125. (The Veterans Highway) south of Speyside.

Chudleigh was nominated

for the honour by the Ontario Farm Fresh Marketing Association which noted he was a leader in the innovative use
