## Man's body found in burned-out vehicle

Two men, one of them local, have been arrested and charged with first degree murder in the death of 48year-old Brian C. Stockton of Milton whose body was discovered in a burning car off Regional Rd. 25 (Highway 25) just south of the Halton Hills boundary on Thursday, June 17.

Arrested are Michael James McDonough, 39, of Fourth Line, Halton Hills, and John Kevin McClatchey, 47, of Westley St., Port Credit.

At approximately 12:20 a.m. on Thursday, June 17, two separate passing motorists alerted Halton Police and the Milton Fire Department

to a car fire at the rear of Traffix, 8420 Highway 25. The car was found fully engulfed in flames. Once the fire was extinguished, the deceased man was located inside the car.

Investigators from Halton police said the man's body was badly burned and made the process of identification difficult. An odontologist (forensic dentist) positively identified the victim as Brian C. Stockton of Milton through the assistance of dental x-rays.

Police were immediately suspicious of the circumstances of the death after preliminary search of the fire scene discovered a secondary scene containing pools of blood investigators believed may be related to the death of the man.

Both accused men will appear in Burlington Court via video remand from the Maplehurst Detention Centre
