

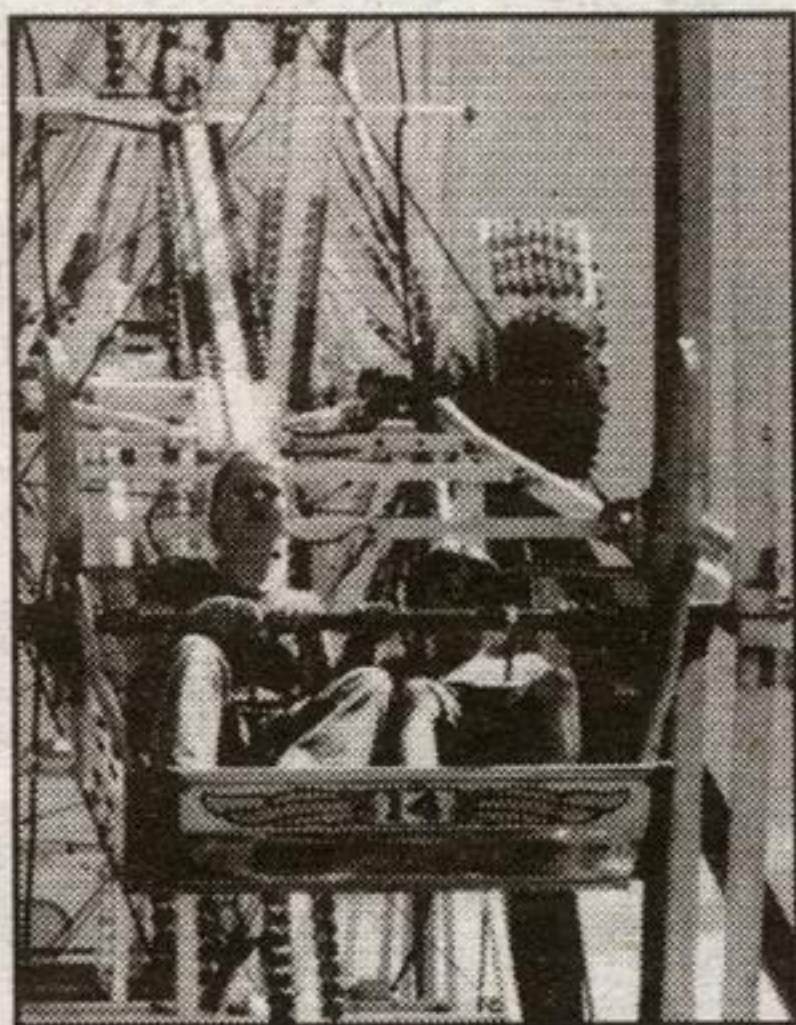
# Rockwood Lions lose - likely last Spring Fair

Rockwood has probably had its last Spring Fair, says Rockwood Lions Club secretary Jim Weatherby who organized the event for the third consecutive year.

"I don't know what's wrong with the people of Rockwood that they don't come out to support us," Weatherby said. "We're just trying to do something for the youth in the community."

While Weatherby could not provide a final figure on the cost of the fair, he said both the club and Campbell's Amusements lost money- again.

"They told us they won't be back," he said. "They can't continue to keep losing money as they've done for the last three years."

The club's beer tent "was a wash" with the club taking in about

\$1,700 in sales after paying around \$1,500 to rent the tent and \$225. for their liquor licence.

The cruise night the club had hoped to include "didn't happen" because of opposition from unnamed people who should have been involved.

Weatherby said they had lots of enthusiasm from some area residents and from their vendors, but the majority of people did not support them. He says the vendors didn't lose money but neither did they do as well as they could have expected.

"I'm very doubtful the fair will happen next year," he concluded.
