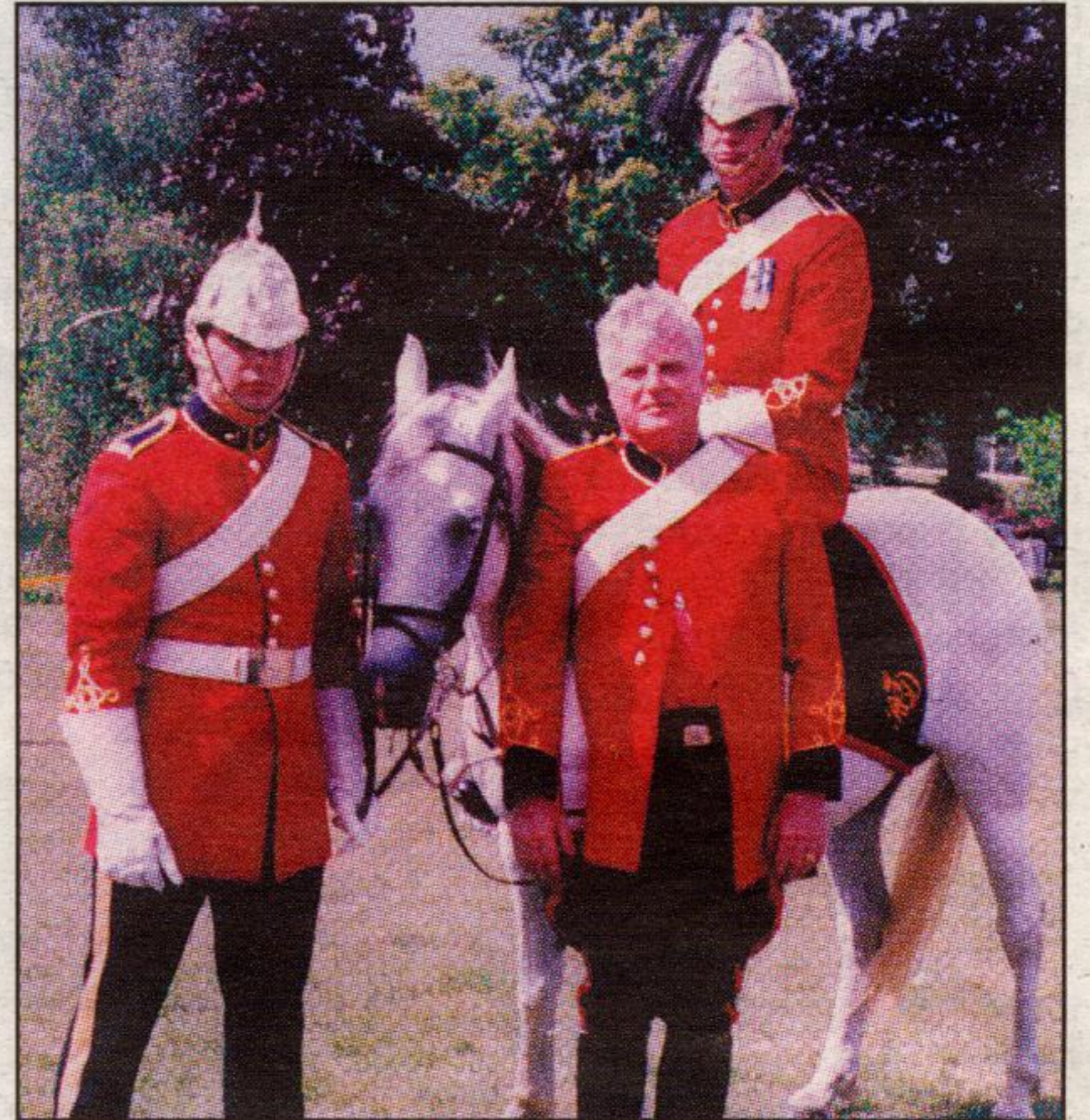
Up the street with only one paddle

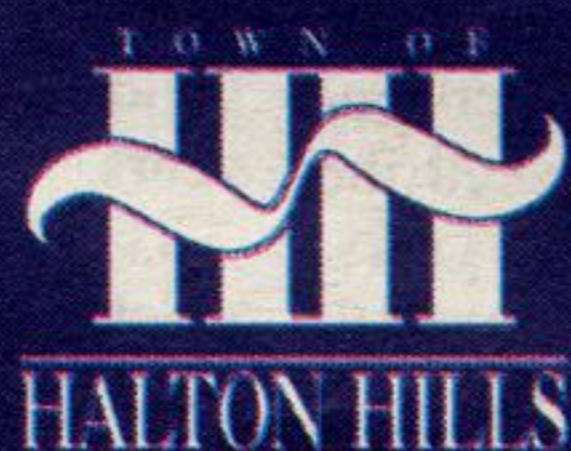
