Prize winners for best floats

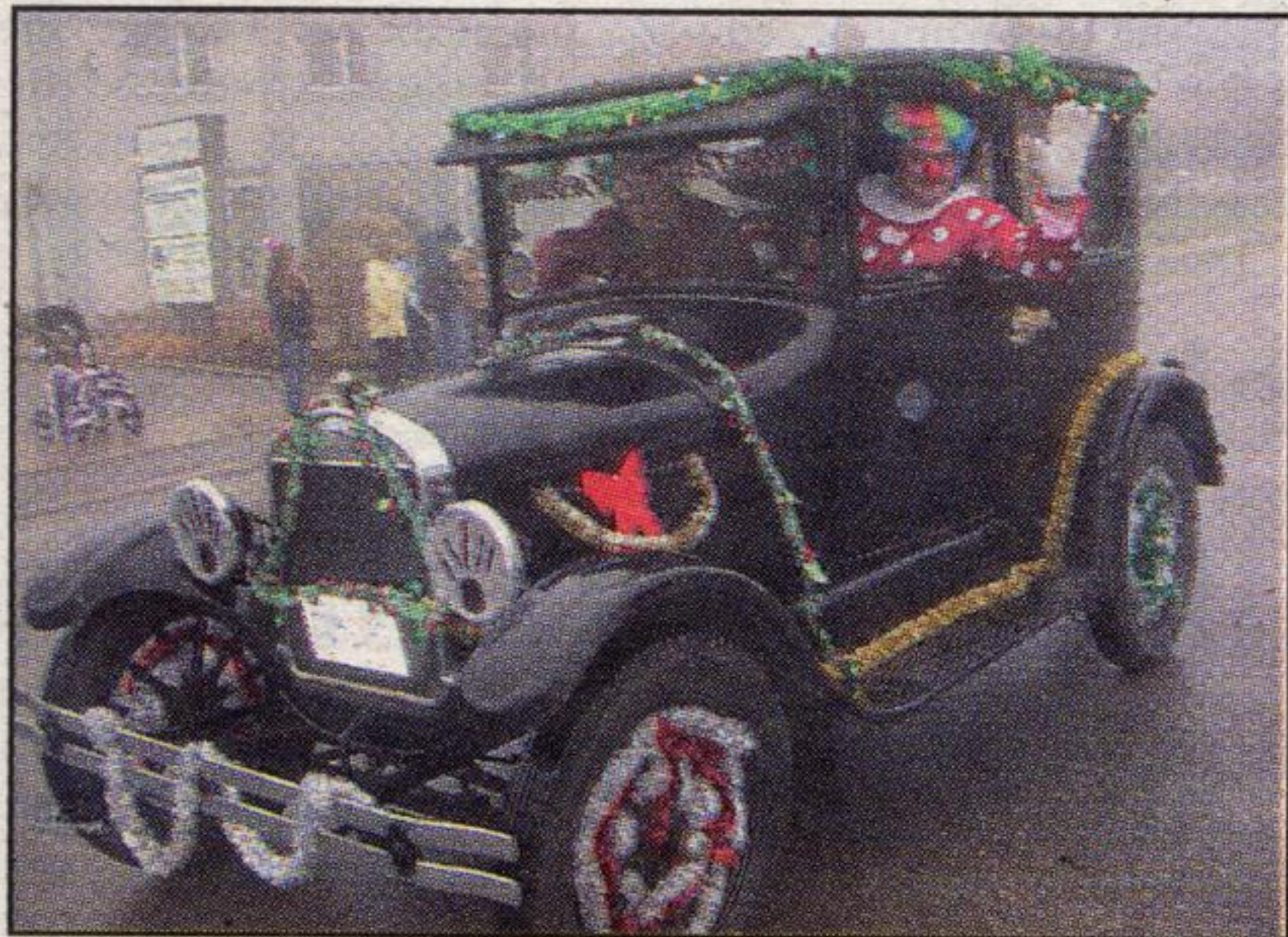

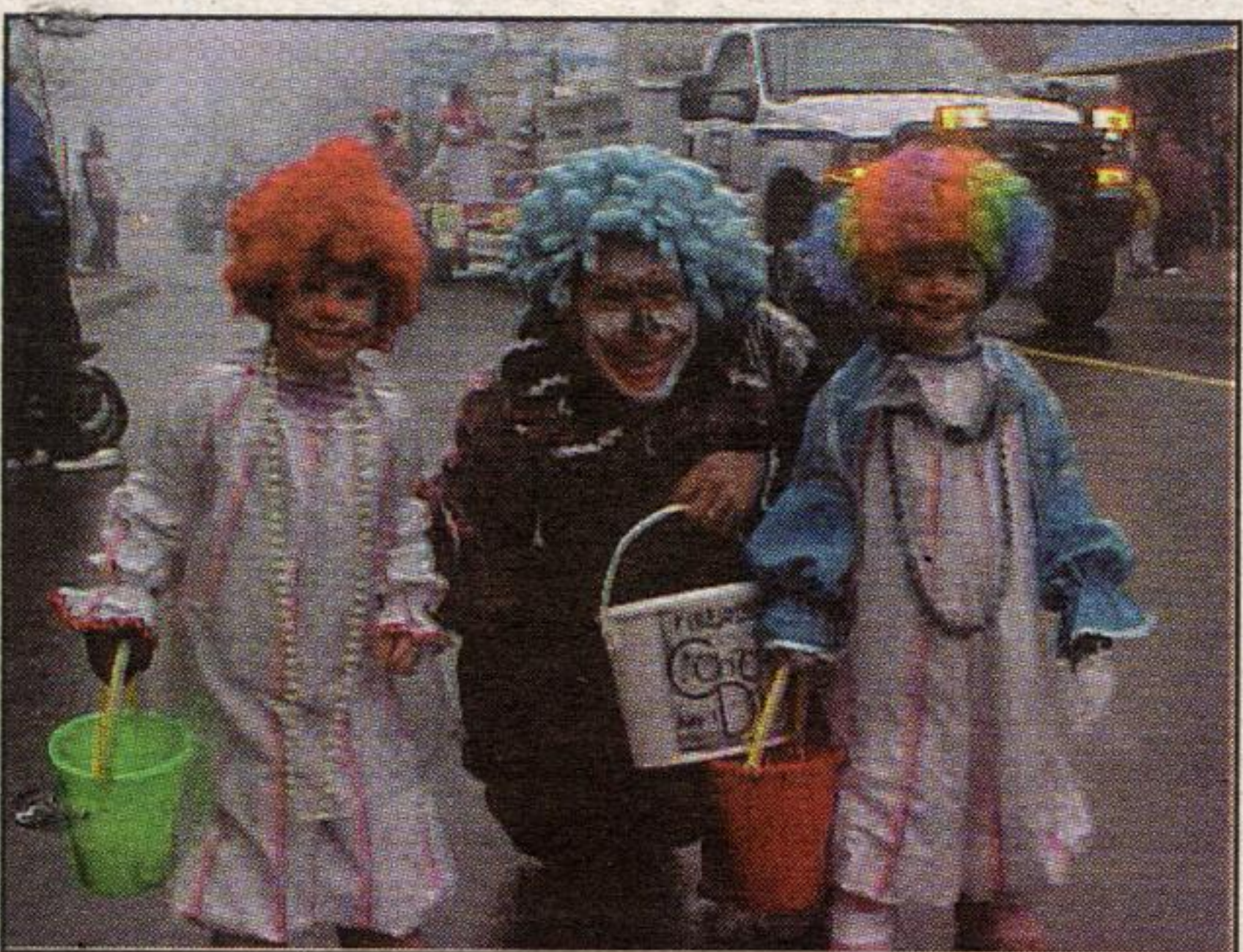

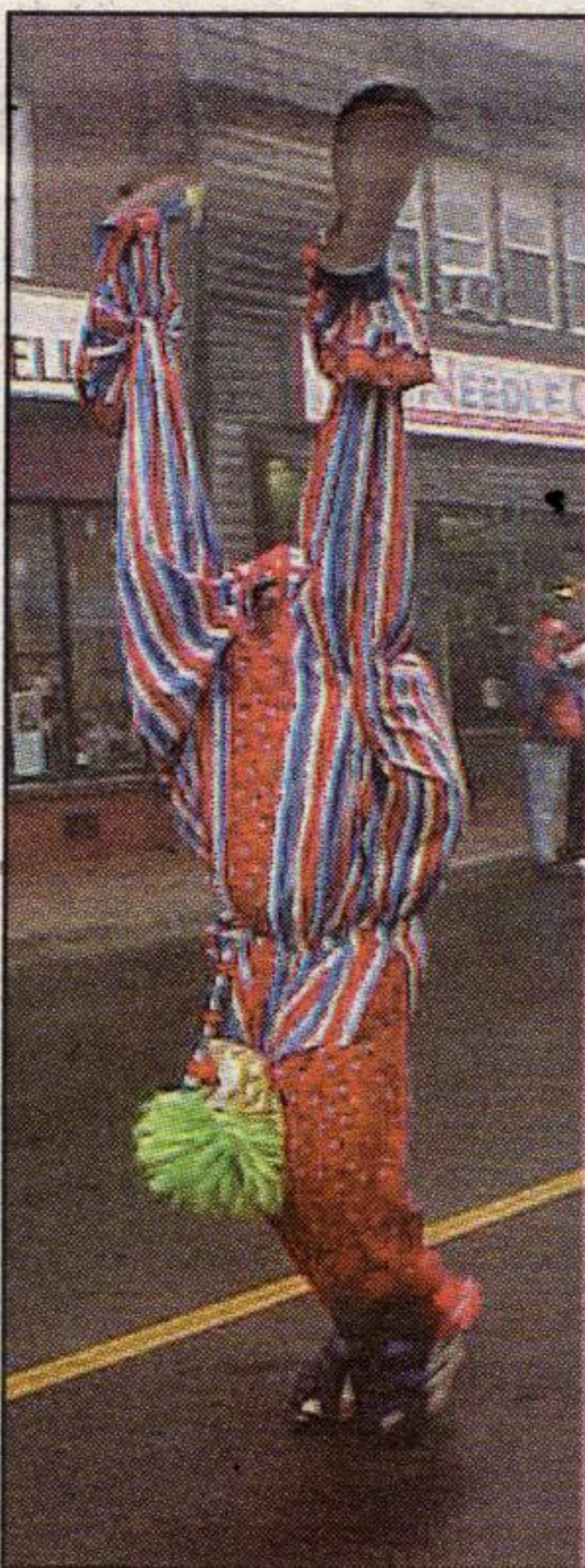
