problem is where people vote, but why people don't vote and "disconnect" from municipal government.

He noted that voting initiatives made almost no difference in voter turnout in Caledon and Orangeville in the last municipal election.

"So, I don't think there's any evidence that necessarily more is better, and I do think we should be spending our time more productively in trying to reconnect with the people," O'Leary said.

Councillors also rejected a suggestion to send the issue to committee for debate, a move Mayor Rick Bonnette felt would be a waste of time and money.

The last election cost \$85,000 to \$90,000.
