

Tanner Peewees chalk up three wins this week

Roger Kirkness took a chance with a sharp angled shot after James Begg tossed him the puck from the side of

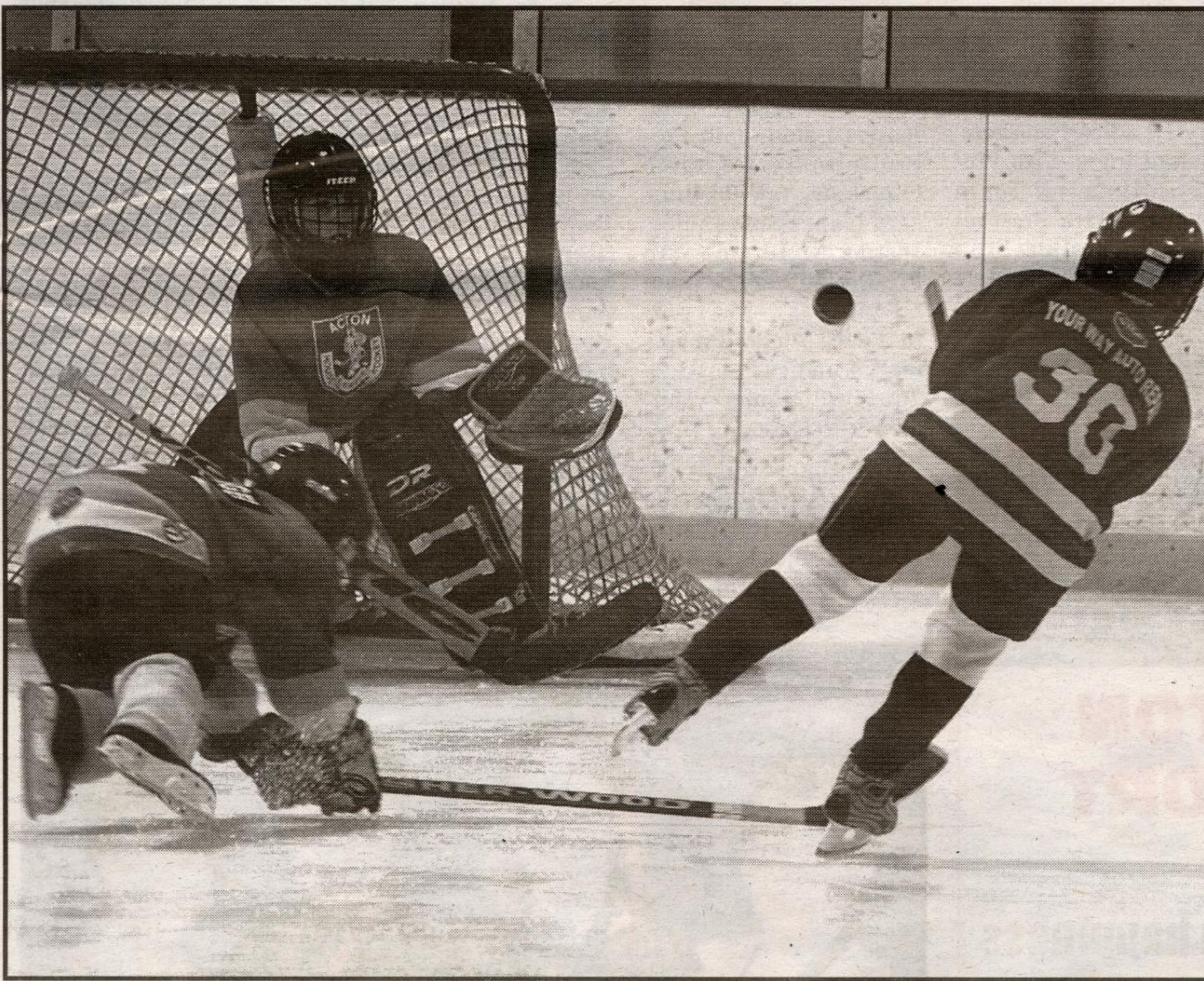
the net. Roger's shot found the far side of the net to see Acton tie up the game.

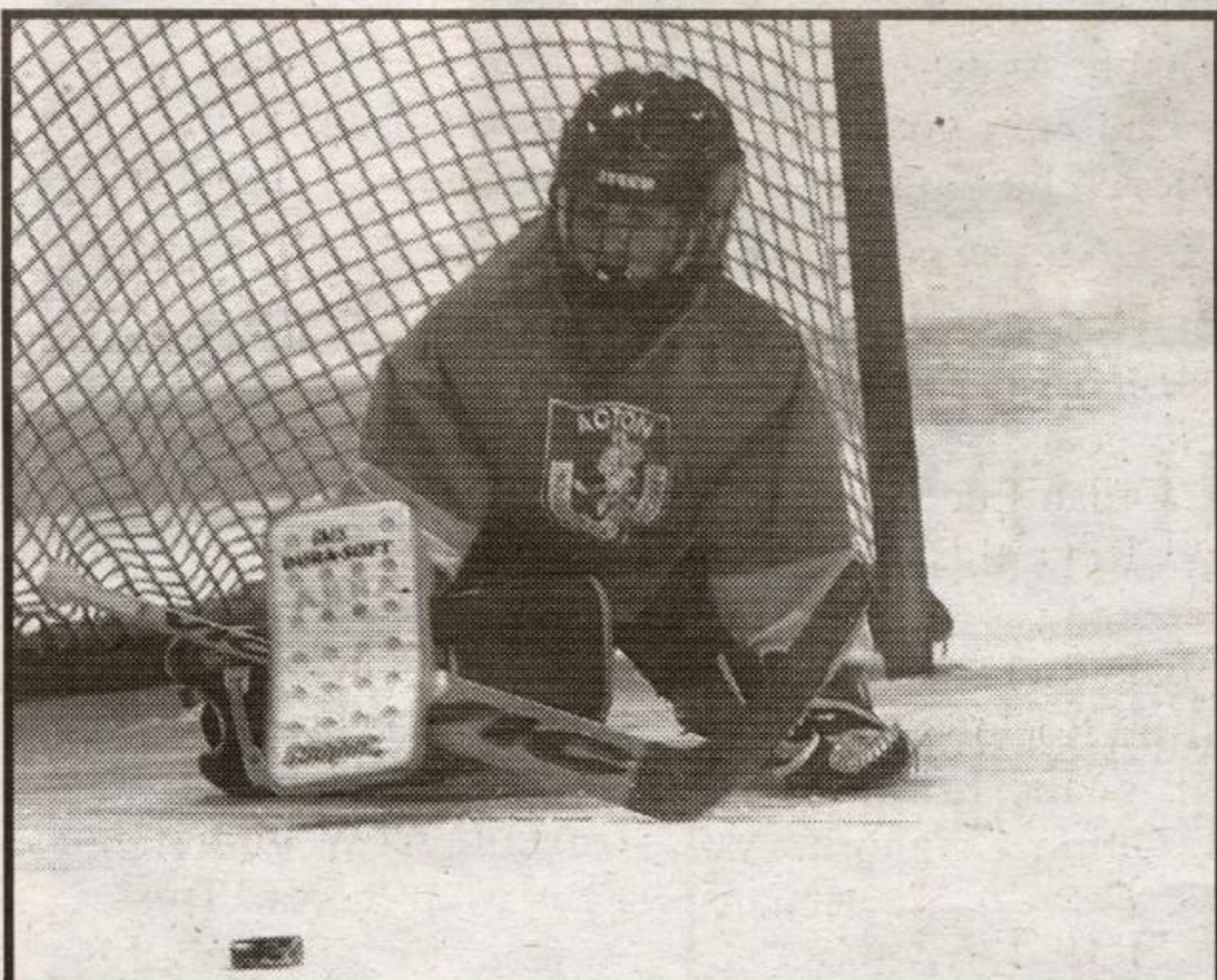
Although the game started to get a little rough, the Acton players kept the game well in check. This was Hespeler's second loss to Acton, this time falling 2 to 1
