#### Rollercoaster weather Driver faces in January colder, warmer than normal

Yes, you were right. According to Environment Canada January was colder than normal in Ontario except for the extreme southwest of the province.

January was a rollercoaster ride of daily record low temperatures, record highs, near blizzards, bitterly cold wind, Alberta clippers, freezing rain and even thunderstorms during the first month of 2005.

The extremes included the warmest January day on record at Pearson Airport, a balmy 17.6C on January 13, and the coldest day when temperatures fell to -40.5C at Thunder Bay on January 16.

Snowfall was variable over Ontario. Hardest hit was Windsor in the province's banana belt where 77 cm of snow fell, twice the usual 33 cm January total.

At the other extreme, Kapuskasing in the heart of Ontario's frigid belt, had only 30 cm, about half the average snowfall and least since 1968.

The month bowed out Monday balancing precariously between above and below zero.
