the shop and pay only \$6 (some items excluded). Come in early for best selection.

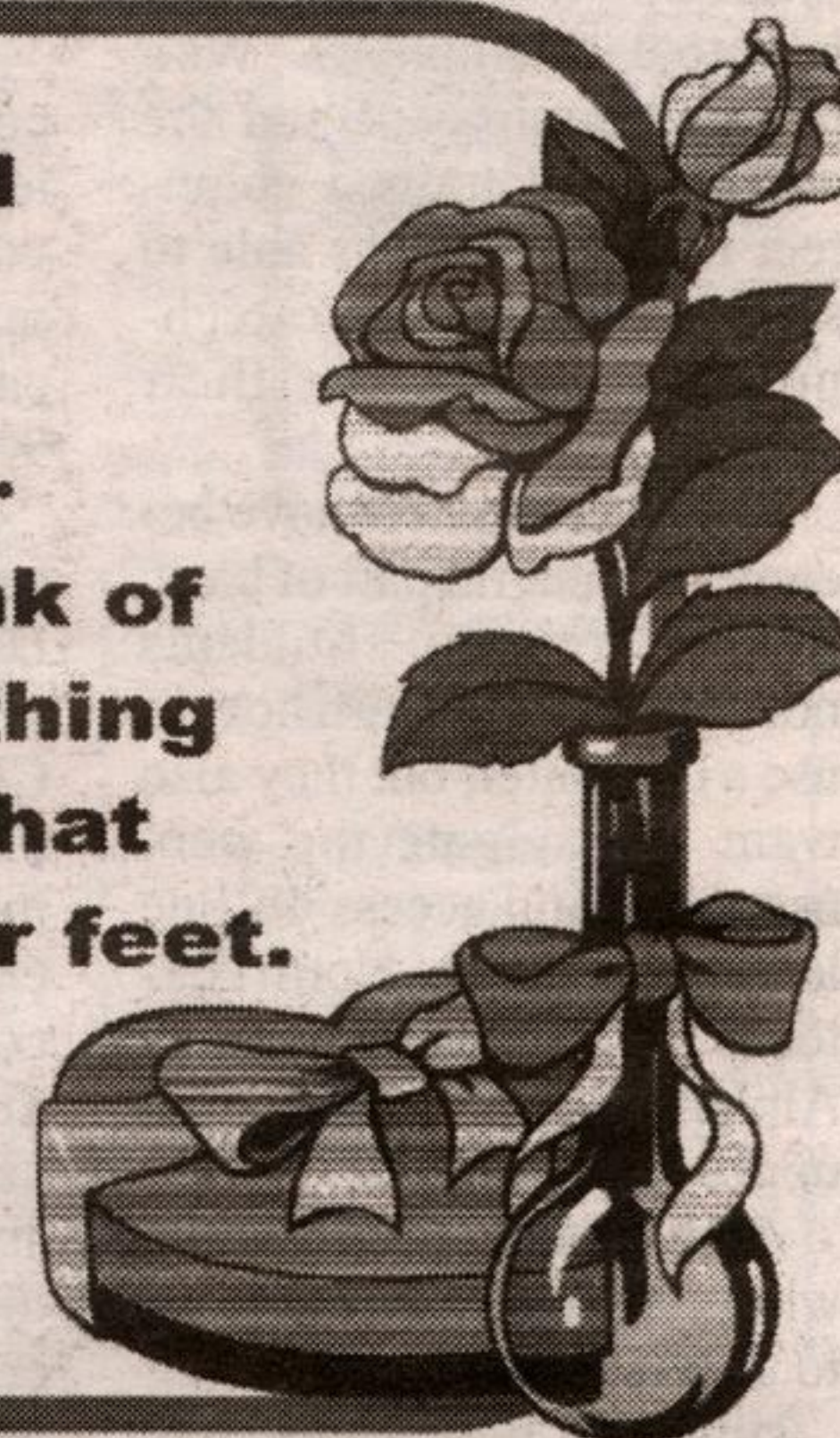
Food Bank Service: Our food bank is open every Tuesday. If you require this service, please call Gillian at 833-9696 for more information on how we can help.

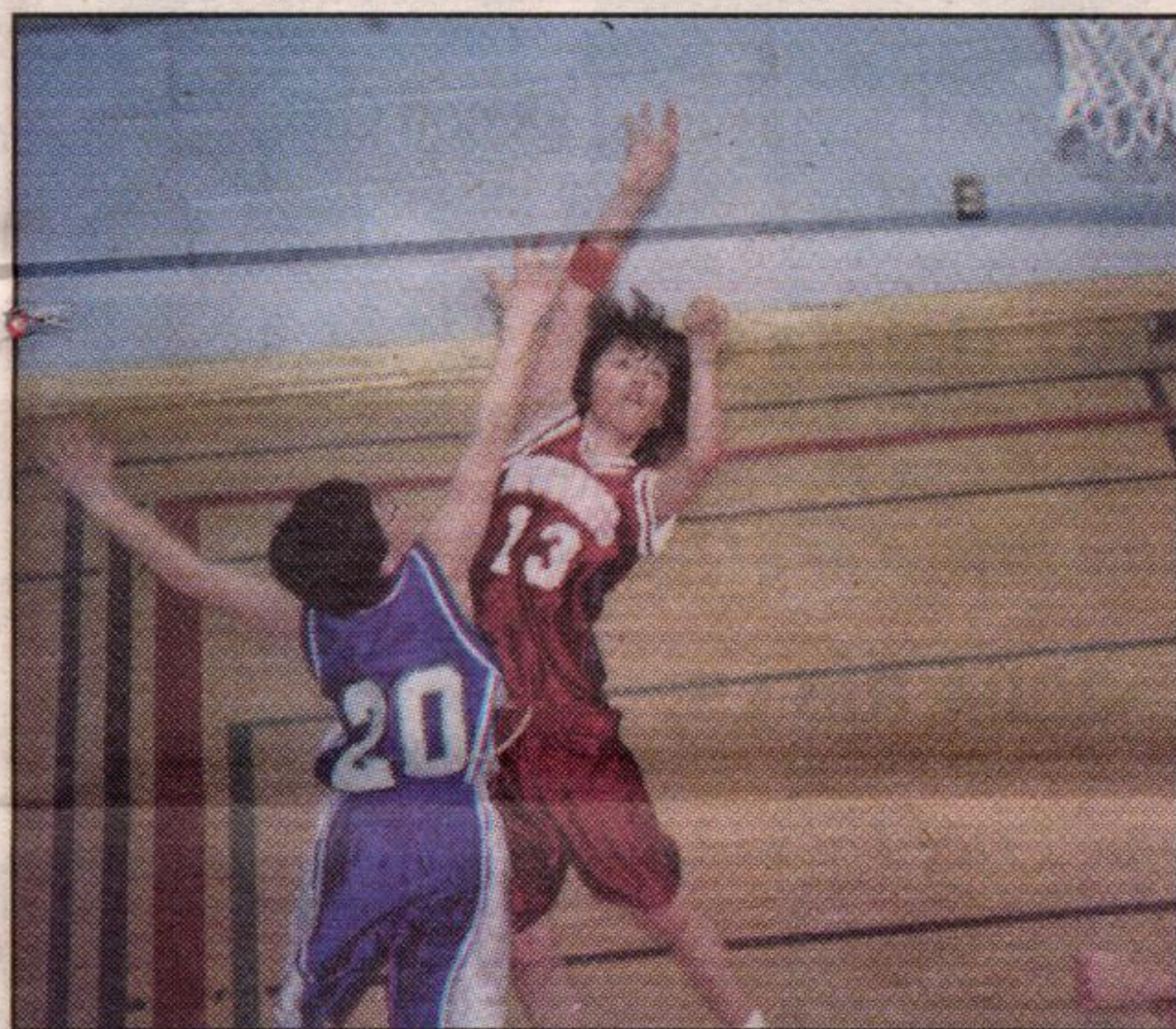

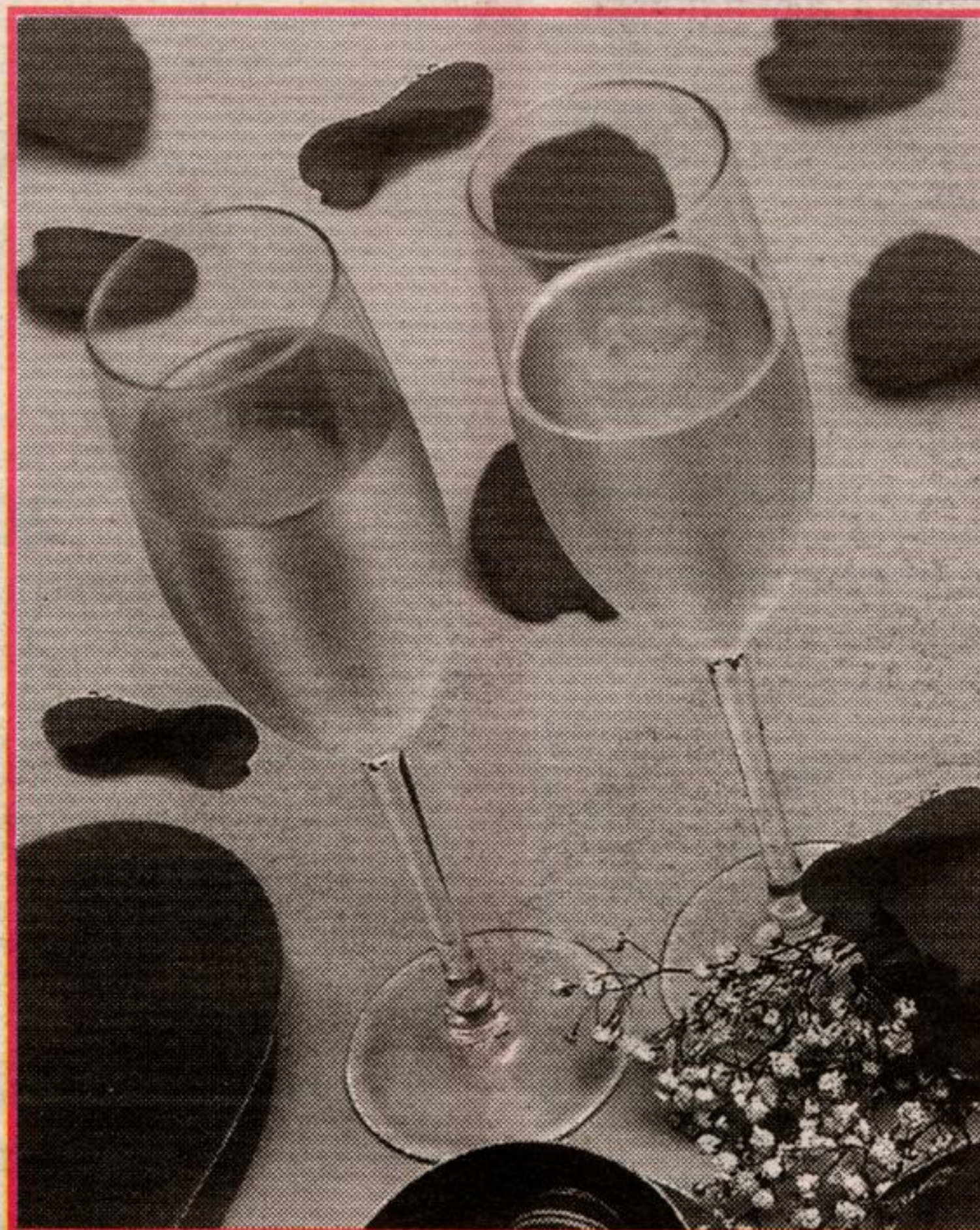
