Lifestyle change helps with prevention

The risk of developing cancer can be increased or diminished by lifestyle choices or the kind of environment people live and work in, the Canadian Cancer Society points out.

However, even a person at low risk may get cancer just as a person with high risk may not. There is no single cause of cancer but some factors appear to increase the risk.

Some riskfactors cannot be changed such as age and family history of cancer (heredity) but there are some factors related to everyday choices that people can change, including:

(a) Avoiding tobacco and tobacco smoke

(b) Eating a healthy diet

(c)Being physically active every day

(d)Staying at a healthy weight (e)Limiting alcohol use

(f)Reducing exposure to UV (ultraviolet) rays from the sun

The Canadian Cancer Society also suggest people should know their body and report any changes to their doctor or dentist and follow health safety instructions when using hazardous materials at home and at work.
