
SuperStore 'jumped the gun'

When Council approved plans for a massive Loblaws SuperStore in Georgetown on May 2, Acton Councillor Clark Somerville questioned how the supermarket giant, normally a good corporate citizen, had jumped the gun and allowed work to begin on the site at Guelph Street and Mountainview Road before all the permits had been issued.

"You could see along on Mountainview where footings were poured," Somerville said, adding it is a highly visible project and people noticed the work starting and stopping.



A company official blamed the contractor for assuming the permits had been issued.

Mayor Rick Bonnette noted Loblaws' senior management cooperated quickly and " called off their crew" with 30 minutes of a phone call from the Town.

The 138,000-square-foot store – roughly four times the

size of Acton's Sobeys - will include a 73,000-square-foot food store and pharmacy, electronics store, housewares, baby wear, photo lab and a fitness centre.

More enforcement

It's time to increase the amount of time Town staff spends on enforcing Town parking bylaws according to Acton Councillor Clark Somerville.

At a recent Council meeting Somerville said for the past six years, staff have spent 20 hours per week enforcing Town parking bylaws.

He said people ask why no parking signs are put up, but not enforced, and suggested additional fines could cover the cost of extra staff to enforce the bylaws.

Henry Tse, the Town's director of Building, Zoning and Enforcement said staff would be happy to take a look at the issue, noting "we don't have enough staff to provide the service we'd like to provide."

Even though 13 will always be a skeptical number, a lot of this could be chalked up to sheer coincidence and folklore. But if you're one of


those people who believes in Paraskevidekatriaphobia or triskaidekaphobia (a fear of the number 13) then tomorrow might just be the day to take a long weekend.


