The candlelight family and children's service scheduled for 7 p.m. at the Acton Corps of the Salvation Army is expected to be "dramatic and effective" according to Corps spokesperson Heather Lambert who expects songs, hymns and the Christmas story.

On Christmas Day, the Corps will hold a service at 11 a.m., and on New Year's Eve, there will be a Watchnight Service in the sanctuary at 11 p.m. to welcome 2006.

For the third year in a row on Christmas Eve, the congregations of Acton's Churchill Community Church and Trinity United Church will join at Trinity at 11 p.m. for a special

service.

They will sing carols and hymns, receive Communion and watch a play about a doctor being called into work on Christmas Eve when a baby is born.

Churchill will also hold a carol sing and Christmas message service at 7 p.m. on Christmas, and no service on Christmas Day. There will be a regular service at 11 a.m. on New Year's Day.

Trinity will also hold a family service with candlelight, carols and the children's and senior choirs at 7:30 p.m. on Christmas Eve. There will be a shorter and more informal service at 10 a.m. on Christmas Day and at 10 a.m. on New Year's Day.

Acton Baptist Church welcomes all to its candlelight service at 7 p.m. on Christmas Eve and its regular worship service at 11 a.m. on Christmas Day.

And, while the pews of many Acton churches may be filled this weekend with people who only show up once or twice a year, that's okay with the spiritual leaders of Acton Christians.
