**Teachers prepare for strike action**

Catholic secondary teachers are prepared to begin to work to rule Tuesday.

They were meeting with the Halton Roman Catholic School Board on Friday for a last ditch effort to avert this job action. The meeting was expected to go round-the-clock and the results were not available before press deadline.

The teachers' union notified the school board last Monday, Feb. 13 that its members intend to start job action Tuesday. This would most likely take the form of a "work to rule" sanction, the school board was told.

It would mean that instructional programs would not be affected, but extra-curricular supervision by teachers of activities like sports events, clubs and dances would stop. Teachers also plan to arrive in the classroom 15 minutes before classes begin in the morning and five minutes before they begin in the afternoon.

"Please be assured that our first priority is the safety of your

children," a letter to parents from the school board said. "Supervision of students will be provided where required. Any facility within a school, such as the gym or other program areas, that in the opinion of the principal cannot be appropriately supervised will be closed."

"We wanted to advise our parents and students, but we're going into it hoping to resolve the issues," school board communications officer Chris Jewell said. He could not comment on which issues still remain to be settled, since he said this might affect direction of the negotiations.

**Year of the Flame**

The request for the proclamation came from the Canadian Society for Yad Vashem, The Holocaust Martyrs' and Heroes' Remembrance Authority. This year is recognized because it is the 50th anniversary of the liberation from Nazi tyranny.

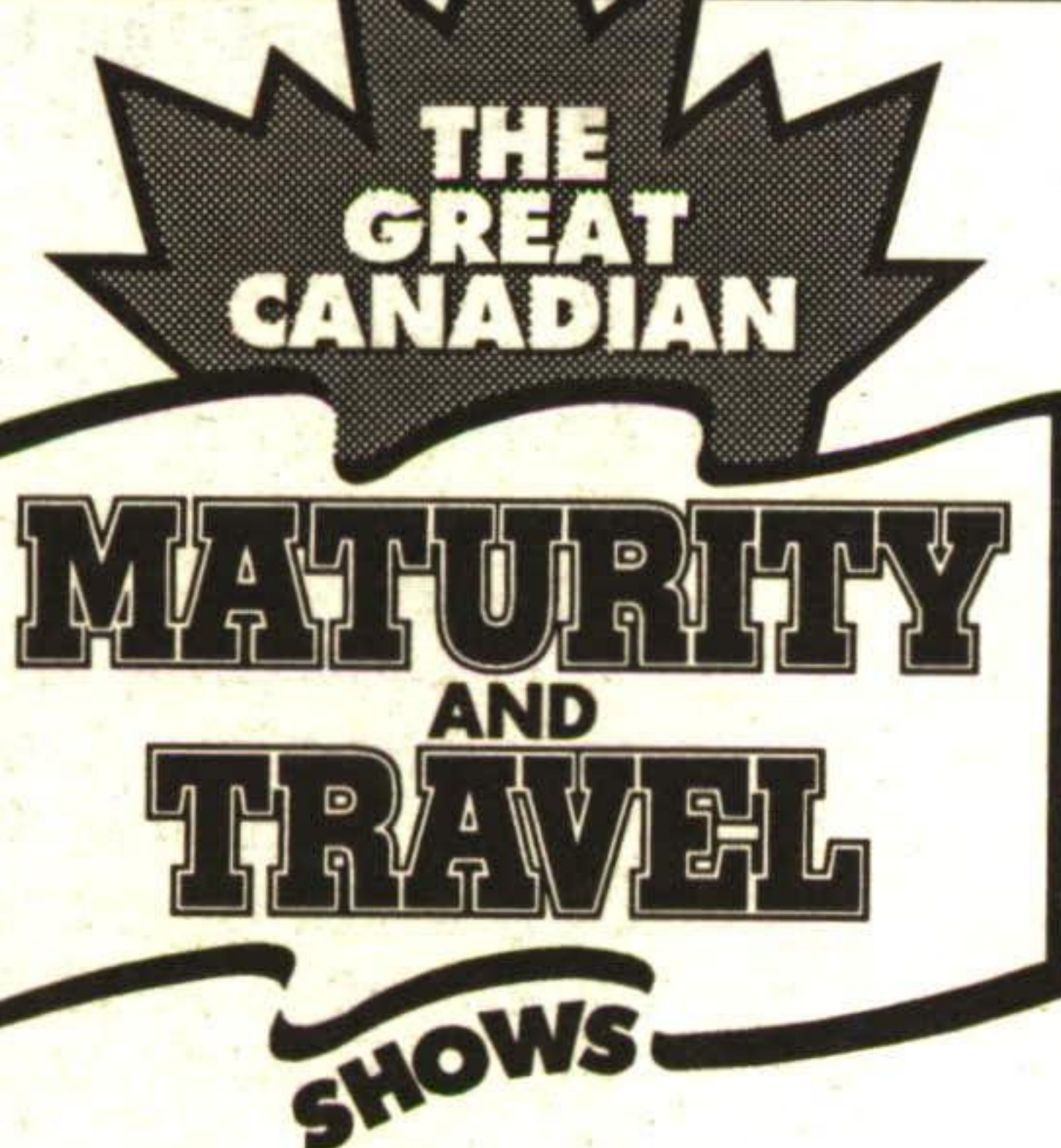
