To cover materials costs \$2 will be collected at the door. Child care is available on site for a cost of \$4 per child care provider.

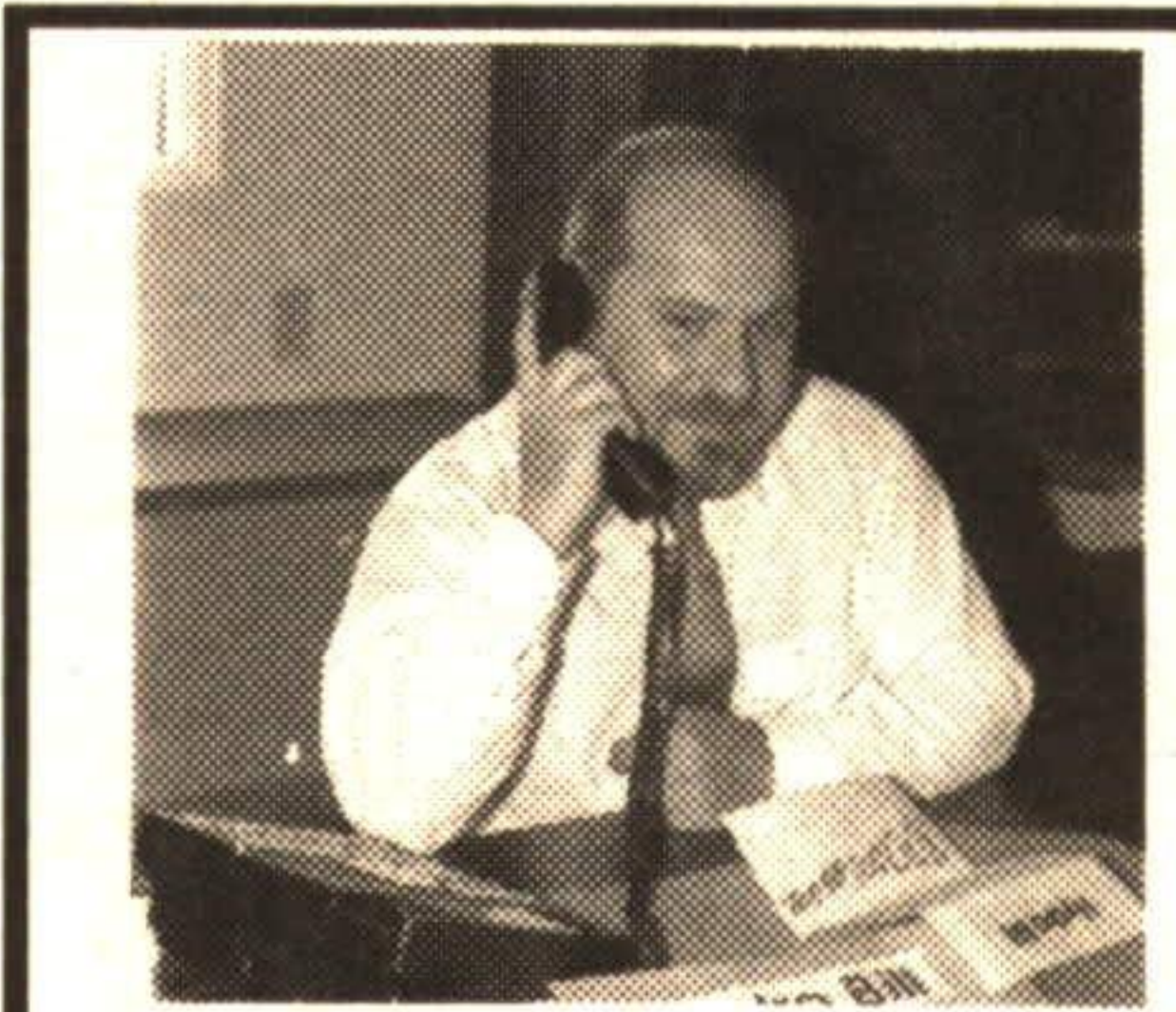
