## Fans desire the Undesireables

Recently a pair of Georgetown musicians showcased their talents as they kicked off a new gig featuring their own special style of music in Toronto.

The Undesirables, better known as Sean Cotton and Corin Raymond, recently opened at the Free Time Cafe on College St., Toronto, offering patrons their own music with a blues flavor.

"When we started in Georgetown," said Cotton, "we were playing a version of Delta Blues and some acoustic blues

as well. But after we played in the Kingston area for a while, we began to write our own stuff, and gathered together a lot of material."

As a result, Cotton and Raymond have developed their own brand of music, "It's kinda New Orleans flavor, with rock and country along with jazz and ragtime all thrown in together," says Cotton.

The group consists of Cotton on guitar, with both members adding to the vocals.

"We knew we had enough material, we were sure of that," said Cotton, "So the time was right to take it somewhere

else. That led us to try performing in Toronto."

Twenty-three-year-old Cotton began his musical interests at 13, starting with a group at Georgetown High School called D-Jay's Nightmare. Later he moved on to a band called Shadows of Laughter and eventually decided to go on his own.

Raymond, on the other hand, started his entertainment career in a broader sense, enjoying a number of different avenues like acting when he was at GDHS and later at Mayfield School's theatre arts program.
