

Ice cream parlor plan opposed

Three people voiced their opposition to a proposed ice cream parlor on Rexway Dr. at a public meeting recently.

Al Castiglione, owner of Pizza Delight, Bill Kort, representing the owner of Dairy Queen, and Rexway Dr. resident Cor Oosterhof, all spoke against the proposal which requires an amendment to the zoning from residential to residential special.

Douglas Turner, who owns the property on 7 Rexway Dr., filed the application with the town. He plans to open the ice cream parlor in an existing addition of the house which was previously used as a barber shop.

Insufficient parking was one of the biggest issues raised by those opposed to the proposal.

Kort said during the summer months the owner of the Dairy Queen on Guelph St. has 700 cars parked in his lot on Sundays and his client is concerned customers from the

Rexway Dr. parlor will use his lot as well. Turner has told the planning department he would have space for three cars at the ice cream parlor.

Kort said patrons of the ice cream parlor will require parking longer than customers of a variety store would, and stressed three spaces weren't enough. He added the owner of Dairy Queen has concerns about the effect the ice cream parlor will have on his business.

He added there were many empty commercial buildings available on Guelph St. with ample parking space.

Rexway Dr. resident Oosterhof said he was opposed to the proposal due to the traffic and parking concerns. He added most of the ice cream parlor customers will be there on weekends and evenings.

"I hope council doesn't drive us out of our

residence," said Oosterhof.

Bert Arnold, representing Turner, said the proposed business offers hard ice cream, a different product than that offered at Dairy Queen. He also said the home has been used for a commercial use since 1959.

He said the business would be centrally located with easy access for pedestrian and bicycle traffic. He added several area homeowners had signed a petition supporting the proposal.

Town staff is expected to report to council on the application in the next couple of weeks.

An Open Letter to Parents and Students

For more then two years, teachers in Halton Region's Catholic high schools have been working without a contract and have been trying to negotiate a fair settlement with the board.

Fact finding and mediation have not resulted in an agreement thus far. Therefore we have withdrawn from all voluntary activities which we normally provide, in our own time, without payment, for the benefit of our students.

Teachers will continue to use school time to provide quality instruction and are hopeful that all voluntary services can be restored quickly. This will occur when the board of Trustees returns to the reasonable bargaining positions that have historically produced settlements which meet the needs of all parties and promote mutual respect.

By working together in good faith, we believe teachers and trustees can protect the exceptional programs for the students in the Catholic high schools of Halton Region.
