

# Fire causing concern for local department

The cause of a fire at a townhouse on Stuart MacLaren Rd. Feb. 26 is still under investigation by the Halton Hills Fire Department and the town's building department.

The fire started between the ceiling and the roof near a chimney which was used for a wood stove, said Halton Hills Fire Chief Bill Cunningham. The wood stove was in use the evening the fire broke out.

The three residents of the unit, a couple and their daughter, escaped uninjured.

About \$43,000 damage was done to the townhouse, but most of it was near the roof, with very little damage to the living area of the home.

The roof was covered with plastic, and repairs are currently being carried out, Cunningham said.

Residents in the townhouse complex

who have wood burning stoves are being asked not to use them until the investigation is complete, he said. Cunningham said the investigation is focusing on construction materials and the installation method. The chimney was made of stainless steel and had a double wall.

The investigation will likely be complete in a couple weeks.
