In general, there are two basic types of radio systems: central dispatch and unitto-unit. The most common type of system is the central dispatch system, in which a communications link is established between a dispatcher and people on the field or in the premises. When the dispatcher wants to call one or more people, he or she transmits the message over the radio system. People on the job, with radios turned to the same frequency, hear the message. Likewise, field personnel may initiate a conversation with a dispatcher or respond to the dispatcher's message. There's no need for a telephone.

Another basic type of system is a unitto-unit system. Some systems may not require a central dispatcher; instead, field or on-site personnel communicate directly with each other. In this type of system, field people are equipped with two-way radios (mobiles and portables) so that each person has the ability to both talk and listen. Everyone in the system can hear each message.

Capabilities such as telephone interconnect can also be added to these basic types of systems. For example, suppose a courier

driver needs to call a customer for directions. With telephone interconnect, the driver can use the two-way radio to access two-way equipment in a fixed location which has been equipped with a phone patch. The call request is then automatically interconnected to the telephone company and the call is completed over standard land line service.

While simple systems like these do exist, you will more than likely require a combination of these systems to meet all of your needs. A consultant at Ratelle can help you determine the best combination.




