## Georgetown seniors seek donations for new centre

While the Acton seniors centre was lucky enough to receive a New Horizons grant from the federal government for \$30,000 to help buy furniture and equipment for their centre, the Georgetown group was not so fortunate.

The parameters of these grants have changed (since Acton received the grant), making them only available to "high risk" seniors, rather than those who are healthy, said Ken Milne, a vice-president of the Georgetown seniors.

Setting up the new centre, which will open up next week, has been costly.

"We had dozens of meetings to decide how to get set up in the most efficient way," he said. "It was a gut-wrenching choice of what we were going to eliminate" from the list of items which were required.

The result is that they have a small list of items which they are hoping might be donated by someone in the community. These include: a piano, VCR, pool or billiard table, color television, small freezer, and a glass-front display case.

"Eventually, through fundraising we would be able to buy them," Milne said. But the seniors have to pay a third of the rent and operating costs for the centre, and if anyone has any of these items in new or condition, the nearly new Georgetown seniors would greatly appreciate the donation, he said.


