

Police Blotter

Impaired driving charge
Halton police have charged a 40-year-old Georgetown man with impaired driving after police observed a car driving erratically on Ninth Line near 10 Sideroad early Wednesday morning. The man is to appear in Milton court on July 24.

Acton break-in
Police are investigating a break and enter which occurred at a Meadvale Rd., Acton home between 7 and 8 p.m. Wednesday. Police say entry was gained through an unlocked door and a purse with about \$4 and personal identification, was stolen.

Chainsaw stolen
Police report sometime between June 13 and 19, a chainsaw, valued at \$600, was stolen from an unlocked barn on 10 Sideroad. Police are investigating.

Tool theft
Police are investigating the theft of about \$400 worth of tools in a gray plastic box from an unlocked garage on Cobblehill Rd. in Acton. The incident occurred sometime between June 10 and 19.

Car damaged
Police are investigating about \$300 worth of damage caused to a 1985 Honda parked on Prince Charles Dr. in Georgetown between 1 and 5:30 a.m. last Friday.

New three-year deal Teachers ratify new collective agreement

At a June 20 special meeting of the Halton Roman Catholic School Board, a new three-year collective agreement with its secondary school teachers was ratified.

This contract, which covers the period from September 1, 1993 to August 31, 1996, complies with the province's Social Contract.

The secondary teachers voted to ratify this collective agreement in a supervised vote conducted by the Education Relations Commission on June 16.

As a result of this contract, two experience increments will be restored on September 1, 1996 to the secondary Catholic teachers in Halton, which was accomplished by a number of adjustments to their collective agreement.

The Pupil-Teacher Ratio (PTR) in Halton Catholic secondary school has been increased from 16.5 pupils to 17.75 pupils on September 1, 1995.

This concession results in net savings to the board of 10.5 teachers, above the staffing targets of the Social Contract.

The department heads and the assistant department heads will now have one more instructional period, which will result in the establishment of 63 more classes in the secondary period.

Adjustments to class sizes were made to the OAC (Ontario Academic Credit), advanced level courses and destreamed Grade 9 classes.

Other adjustments were also made to the health benefits section of the secondary teachers collective agreement.

The ratification of this contract by both parties results in the full and immediate withdrawal of the "work-to-rule" sanctions which were imposed by the secondary teachers on February 21.

Fact finder issues report

Professor Richard Jackson, the fact finder, appointed by the Education Relations Commission in the negotiations between the secondary teachers and the Halton public school board, submitted a report to the Education Commission on June 16.

The teachers and trustees now have a period of 15 days (until the end of June) for further negotiation

on the basis of this report. There is a provision for an additional five days under Section 26 (3) of the Act if both the trustees and the teachers agree and the Commission approves.

If at the end of this time the parties have not made or renewed an agreement, then the Education Relations Commission will make the fact finder's report public.

INFORMATION TOWN OF HALTON HILLS FINAL TAXES TO HALTON HILLS RATEPAYERS

The first instalment of the 1995 Final Taxes is due:
TUESDAY, JUNE 27TH, 1995 - REALTY AND BUSINESS

Taxes may be paid at the Finance Department (1 Halton Hills Drive, Georgetown), Halton Hills Hydro Office (43 Alice Street, Acton). After hours, by cheque, at the Town Civic Centre Night Depository located at the main entrance or any branch of the Canadian Imperial Bank located within the Town of Halton Hills subject to a service charge. Cheques post-dated and received by the due date are also acceptable and will ensure that instalment dates are not missed. Tax payments beyond the due dates must be paid at the Finance Department.

A Penalty of 1.25 per cent per month will be charged on the first day of each calendar month until taxes are paid.

Failure to receive a Tax bill does not excuse the property owner or business operator from responsibility for payment, nor relieve him/her from liability of penalty for late payment.

Payment by Telephone

At present the Town has agreements with C.I.B.C., Bank of Montreal, Toronto Dominion and Canada Trust who offer the ratepayer this option. CHECK WITH YOUR BANK FOR FURTHER INFORMATION.

Pre-authorized Payment Plans

The Town has also implemented two types of pre-authorized payment plans, a 10 month instalment plan (beginning again January 1996) or the 4 instalment payment plan. (Instalment plan may begin in September 1995. Please enroll thirty days prior to the September due date).
