

University students to spend summer doing Halton Hills rural road inventory

Two University of Guelph graduate students will be spending their summer developing an inventory system for the town's rural roads.

Guelph residents, Alex Law and Michael Crechiolo, both in the landscape architecture masters program at the University of Guelph, will be devising a process to inventory the environmental, cultural and historical aspects of rural roads.

The two will be paid for their work largely through a grant from the Ontario Heritage Foundation and Niagara Escarpment Commission, as well as Heritage Halton Hills and the Town Environmental Advisory Committee.

"We will be trying to protect the scenic views from the roads," said Law. He added the goal is to preserve and enhance the roads.

Eric Connolly, chair of Heritage Halton Hills, says the first task of the two will be to determine what other municipalities are doing, if anything, to inventory their rural roads.

"Their main thrust will be to come up with a way of inventorying the rural roads, looking at the ecological and cultural aspects as well as vegetation, habitats and history of the road," said Connolly.

After they have come up with the system they will test it on three or four different sections of rural roads in Halton Hills.

This summer project is an upshot of a previous summer project done in the town which focused on preserving rural landscapes.

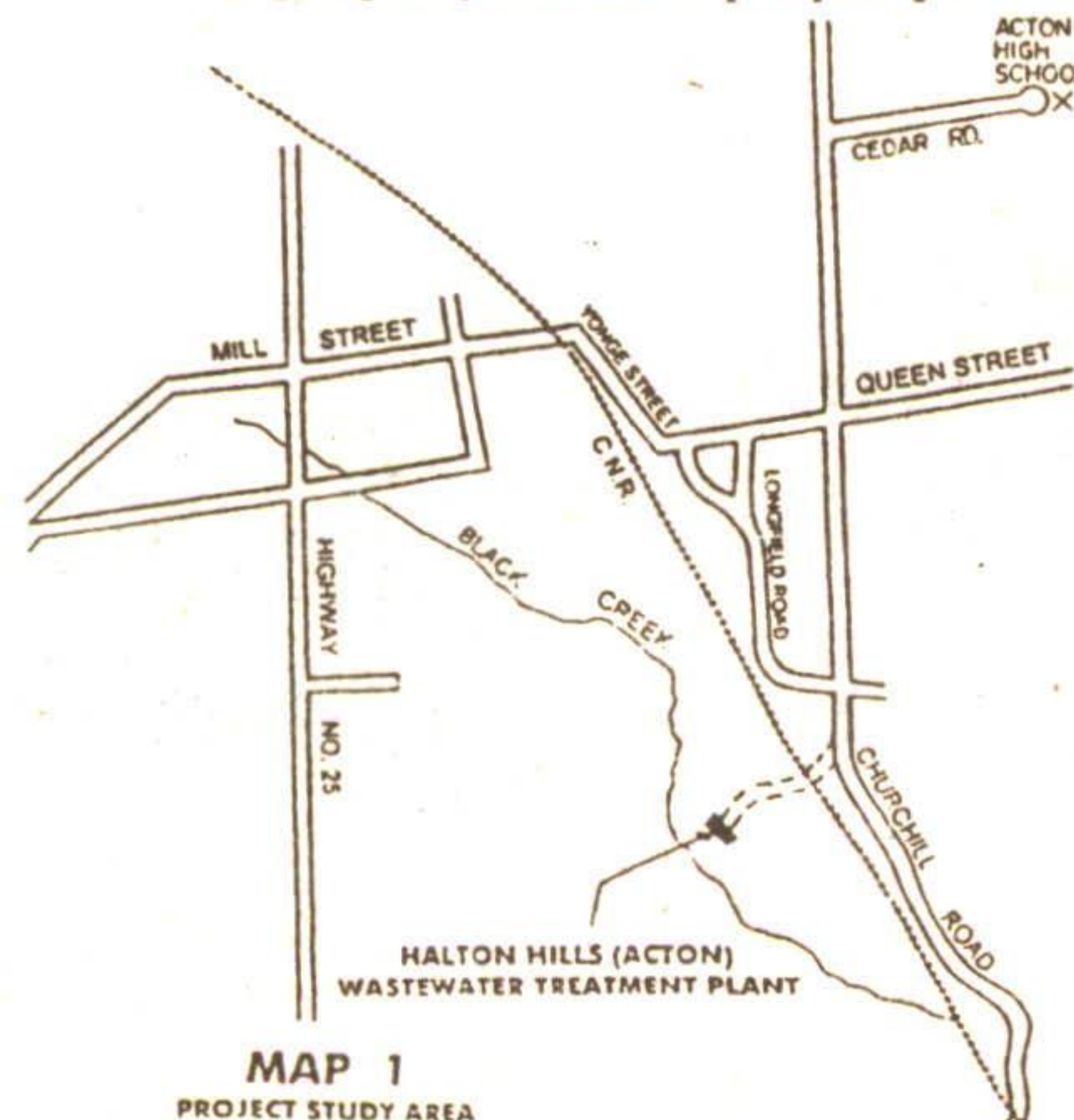

REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF HALTON ACTON WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT IMPROVEMENTS TOWN OF HALTON HILLS (ACTON) PR-1510(A) PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE

The Regional Municipality of Halton is undertaking engineering design for improvements at the Acton Wastewater Treatment Plant in the Town of Halton Hills (Acton). The Acton Wastewater Treatment Plant presently serves a population of approximately 7,000 in the Community of Acton. The existing plant, while performing well in general, requires improvements to the effluent filtration system, effluent disinfection system and ammonia treatment systems. These improvements will further enhance the water quality in the Black Creek Ecosystem. The proposed improvements are also consistent with the direction of the recent Ontario Municipal Board Hearing held to address community growth/servicing requirements. The Ontario Municipal Board Hearing recognized and supported the continuing development of Acton and the necessary infrastructure. In addition to addressing community growth and water quality of Black Creek, the proposed improvements will also address efficient operations and plant reliability. All construction work will take place within the existing property, no new property is to be acquired.



The proposed Wastewater Treatment Plant improvements falls under Schedule "A" of the Municipal Engineers Association Class EA for Municipal Water and Wastewater Projects. As such, no further EA approval is required. A Public Information Centre will be held to give the public an opportunity to view findings, preliminary drawings and provide comments on the project.

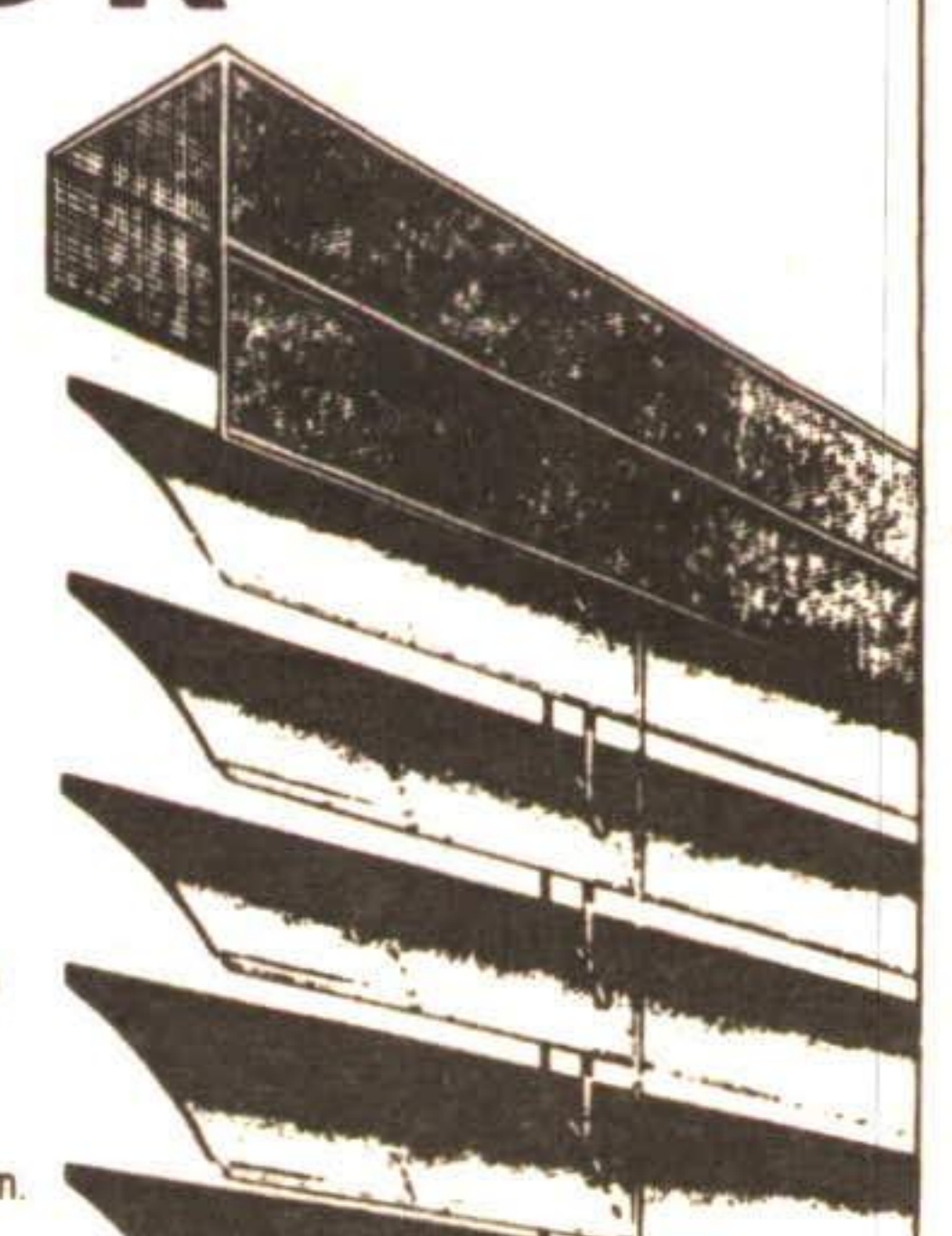
