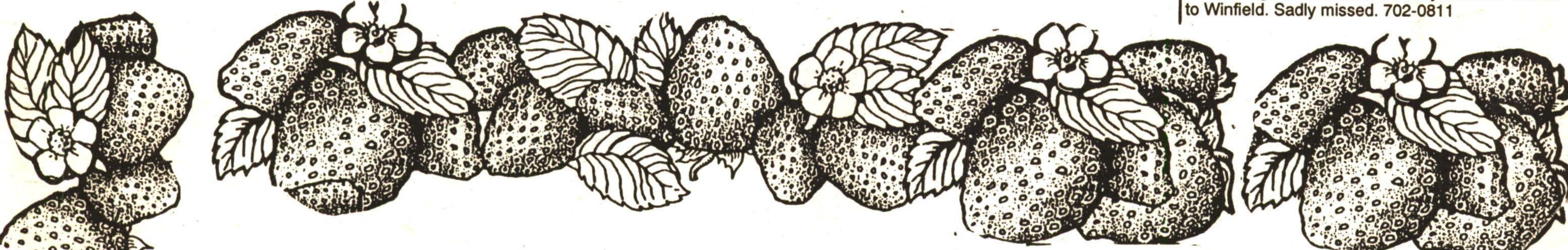

**Strawberry Muffins (make 12)**

400 mL (1 3/4 cups) all purpose flower	1 egg
15 mL (1 tbsp) baking powder	300 mL (1 1/4 cups) milk
2 mL (1/2 tsp) salt	50 mL (1/4 cup) shortening, melted
50 mL (1/4 cup) sugar	200 mL (3/4 cup) fresh Ontario strawberries whole or sliced

- Sift together first 4 ingredients.
- Beat together egg, milk and shortening
- Add liquid to dry ingredients, only until combined. Stir in strawberries.
- Spoon into 12 medium sized, greased muffin cups.
- Bake at 200°C (400°F) 20-25 min or until golden brown.
- Serve hot from the oven.
