

## Strawberry Muffins (make 12) 300 mL (1 1/4 cups) milk 50 mL (1/4 cup) shortening, melted 200 mL (3/4 cup) fresh Ontario strawberries whole or sliced

Sift together first 4 ingredients.

15 mL (1 tbsp) baking powder

50 mL (1/4 cup) sugar

2. Beat together egg, milk and shortening

400 mL (1 3/4 cups) all purpose flower

- 3. Add liquid to dry ingredients, only until combined. Stir in strawberries.
- 4. Spoon into 12 medium sized, greased muffin cups.
- 5. Bake at 200°C (400°F) 20-25 min or until golden brown.
- 6. Serve hot from the oven.
