Outdoor renovations

Home improvement time

At this time of year everyone seems to get in the mood for home improvement and

renovation.

Maybe it's the months spent cooped-up indoors with only dreams of long summer days to keep us warm. Or maybe it's the promise of spending a tax refund in a way that will last for years to come.

Whichever way you look at it, home improvement makes sense. So much so, that the nineties have witnessed a real boom in the home renovation market with Canadians spending more than \$16 million annually on their homes.

Making these improvements to our properties through the addition of outdoor building projects, not only appeal to our sense of aesthetics and pleasure, but can improve the real estate value of our homes.

Privacy fences, multi-level pool and patio decks, picnic tables, storage sheds, flower display racks, swing sets - there are limitless ways to add excitement to your outdoor environment.

However, it's one thing to dream of a beautiful gazebo and it's another to come up with a building plan for the project. That's where the Canadian Institute of Treated Wood (CITW) can help.

Every year the CITW provides Canadian homeowners with a wide variety of free doit-yourself design plans for backyard

projects.

"You can't just start throwing things together. It should be planned properly or you stand to lose your invested time and money," cautions Henry Walthert, Executive Director of the Canadian Institute of Treated Wood. "That's why we make a variety of plans available to the public. It's part of our commitment to providing customers with useful information."

Using pressure treated wood for any outdoor home improvement project will not only save you money in the long run but ensure that you won't have to re-invest

more time and energy re-doing your efforts after a few short years.

Treated Wood Saves Trees

That's because properly treated wood can last for up to 5 decades and requires less maintenance than untreated wood.

"The face that it last much longer than untreated wood also makes it better for the environment," adds Walthert. "Using pressure treated wood means we need to cut down fewer Canadian trees."

"For example," he continues, "Take an average backyard deck. The deck might call for two or three trees worth of lumber but if you use untreated wood you'll probably have to replace part of all of it every few years. Using pressure treated wood instead means that the deck could last up to 50 years."

In addition to decks, pressure treated wood can be used for a variety of gardening jobs such as driveway and flower borders and raised garden beds. In fact, a recent study conducted by independent researchers through Texas A&M laboratories and Southwest Research Institute confirmed that when it's used properly, treated wood is safe for all types of gardens.

Proper use includes choosing the right kind of treated wood for the job at hand. Walthert explains, "Not all treated wood is the same and you should know what it will be used for before you buy it."


For example, he advises using "incised" wood for jobs where the wood will come in contact with the ground. "The incising process allows the preservatives to penetrate the wood deeper and more completely, thus protecting it from the natural elements," he explains.

Consumers can easily identify incised wood by the staple-like incisions on the wood's surface.




