


# Church offers concert series



#### CRABGRASS - CAN IT BE CONTROLLED?

Over the past couple of weeks, crabgrass has been flourishing along driveways, sidewalks and boulevard. It is recognizable by it's wide, light green coloured leaf, usually growing in a clump. Control of Crabgrass is best done early in the spring, prior to the rooting of the Crabgrass seeds.

However, if there are signs of it in the summer it can also be controlled then too. Crabgrass seed germination occurs when the temperature of the soil surface reaches about 18°C (65°F) which would explain it's appearance during the hot weather.

In the spring the crabgrass control material forms a protective barrier on the soil surface which helps control the growing tips of Crabgrass seeds. If the spring application is missed, a post-emergent treatment may be applied. This treatment is best applied when the Crabgrass plants are very young (right now is a good time). This application works on contact (rather than forming a protective barrier on the soil surface). Treating Crabgrass at this time can be very effective. It also allows for a "spot treatment" approach (treating only those areas which are infested).

Once the Crabgrass is controlled, seeding the bare areas may be necessary. It is also very important that the desirable lawn grasses be properly nourished with fertilizer. A thick healthy lawn will shade the soil surface to help control additional crabgrass seeds from surviving during the season.

### COMMUNICATING

It isn't always easy to communicate with a hearing-impaired person. Even patients who wear hearing aids may have problems hearing and understanding in noisy situations, especially if their aids are not kept in proper working condition. Follow these guidelines to avoid communication problems between yourself and a hearing impaired person.

Wait until the person is facing you, then, lead off by addressing him or her by name. Always face your patient while talking and make sure the room is adequately lighted. Remember, the eyes help us hear. Even people with normal hearing use their eyes to help get the full impact and meaning of what another person is saying.
