Where are the candidates?

Still no candidates have registered to run for school board trustee on the Halton Board of Education for Ward 1 and 2. Candidates have been able to register since July 31, when the October 23 by-election was officially announced. Dave Whiting was acclaimed to the post but resigned to accepted a job in Nova Scotia.

Council cancelled

The council meeting on Monday Oct. 23 has been cancelled since that is the day of the byelection for the Halton Board of Education. Instead, a meeting will be held on Monday, Oct. 30, the fifth Monday of the month, when a meeting doesn't normally take place.

New committee

A new committee will be formed by council to draft a procedural bylaw on how meetings should be conducted. It will be made up of the clerk, deputy clerk and four members of council.

Elderly Day

The town has declared Oct. 1, 1995 the International Day for the Elderly in Halton Hills. The request came from Help the Aged (Canada), an organization based in Ottawa which is dedicated to the plight of elderly poor.

Reservations must be made by calling a provincial park directly.

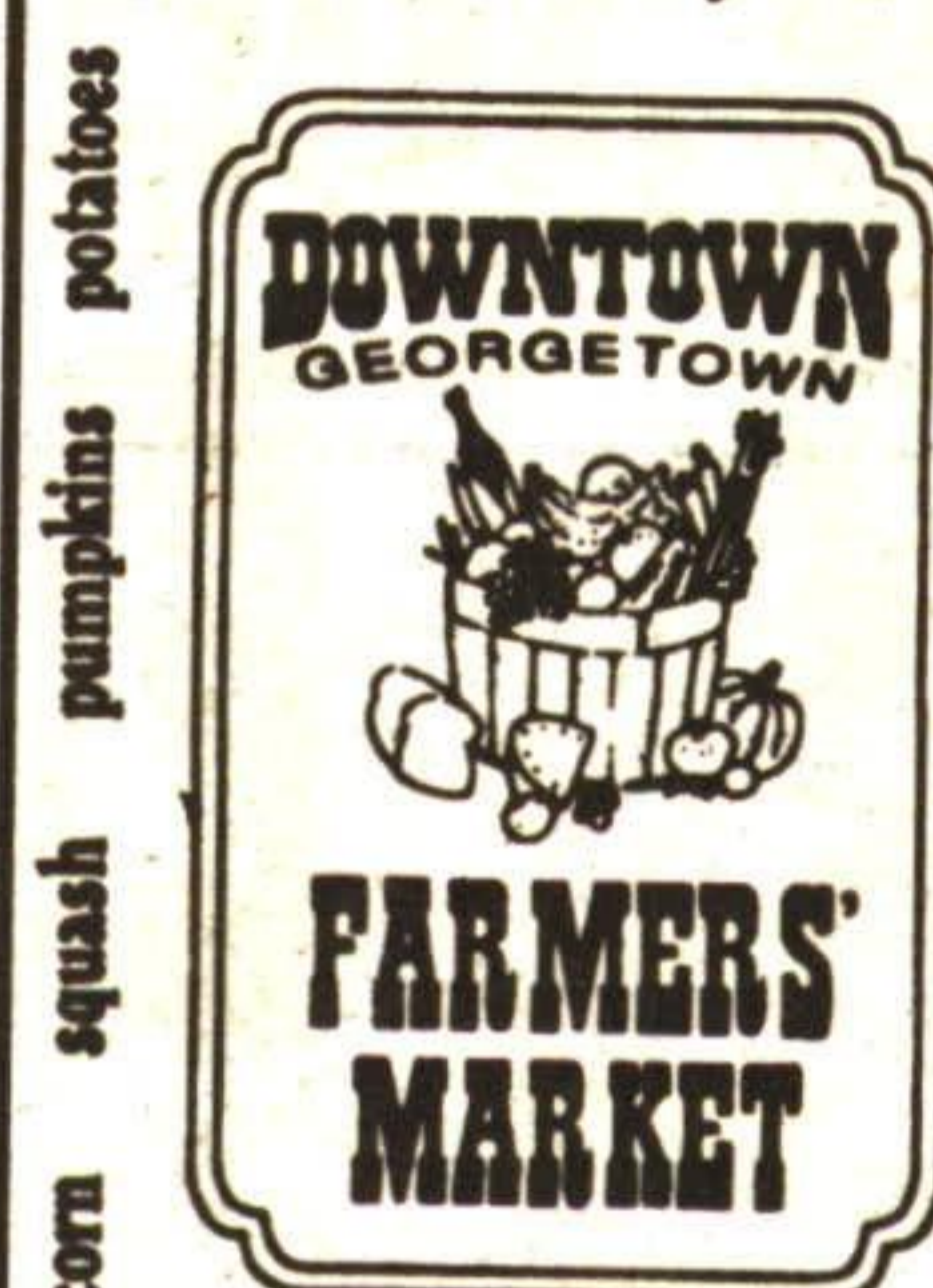
