Ludwig Van Beethoven had a severe hearing loss and, for most of his later life, could not even hear the masterpieces which poured from his tortured soul. Once, conducting his own music, someone had to turn him around to face his audience because he did not realize they were cheering him. The terrible burden of his hearing defect may be understood from these words, spoken just before he died: "I shall hear in heaven." Yet he did his best to conquer his loss - he discovered that, by fastening a stick of wood to his piano and clenching the other end in his teeth, he could faintly hear his music as he played. In doing this, Beethoven was using a principle already known to science - that the bones of the head conduct sound.
