One of the hazards of being in the construction business is having your equipment damaged when staff are away from the job site.

A company working in Georgetown has suffered from this type of vandalism of late, and Crime Stoppers would like to help arrest the trend.

One of the more recent occurrences took place in the area of Argyll and Mountainview, near Hungry Hollow. Machinery was left by workers at 6 p.m. on Saturday, July 29th.

When staff returned at 6:30 a.m. the following Monday, windows had been smashed, and engines tampered with, on

five machines.

The initial estimate for the cost to repair the equipment was placed near \$2,500 by the victimized company.

Crimes Stoppers would like to hear from anyone who can suggest possible suspects for investigation.

If you have any information that leads to an arrest in this or any other case, you may be eligible for a cash reward of up to \$1,000.
