Friday night starts off with a Bang! when Big Fat Paul from Montreal brings in his crew and puts on the first Monster Truck and Crashes show at the Georgetown Fair. Immediately following the Monster Trucks F-16, last year's winners of the Battle for the Bands, will perform.

While over in the agricultural building, promptly at 6 p.m. the first Georgetown Fair's Ambassador competition takes place. Why not take in the Ambassador competition and also take the time to see the display of the vast assortment of home baking, jams, pickles and canned fruit as well as hand crafted knitting and sewing items all beautifully displayed for viewing.

The junior exhibit gives young people a change to exhibit with

pride their artwork, baking, flower arranging and sewing. The Children's Prize List has categories for children 3 years of age and up. The fair holds a special excitement when a child knows that his or her craft work is on display for all fair goers to see. While some categories offer prizes for simple artwork or items made from household articles, others give children of varying ages the opportunity to be truly creative. Each year the judges are impressed by the quality and effort the children put forth in their entries. The complete children's prize list is included in the Fair Prize Book available at stores throughout Halton Hills and at the libraries.

The Children's Education Tent will house over 4,000 sq. ft. of agricultural exhibits including beef show, horse show and a dairy exhibit. This is a must see at the fair and the children will get hands on experience about the farm.

On Saturday after a few rides on

the fabulous Conklin Midway you enjoy the country western style of Neil Cotton beginning at noon. After a few songs it will be time to head on over to watch the Imperial Hell Drivers set for 2:30 p.m. Then while waiting for the ever popular Demolition Derby relax and enjoy not only the music of The King Beats who sing every thing from I'm Henry the Eighth to the Phantom of the Opera. To close out the fair on Saturday we have an up and coming group Allister Scragg ready to perform southern rock at 8 p.m.
