Many people risk their hearing by either wearing earplugs loosely or wearing no protection at all so they will be able to hear voices, machinery, or music more clearly.

Noise-induced hearing loss is a function of exposure time, the average noise level and the peak level of very loud sounds. Some people seem to be more susceptible to hearing loss than others, so that protection on the basis of an average time and sound level exposure will only protect the "average" person.

And for the golfer successful enough to sink a hole-in-one, he or she will be the recipient of a new car, compliments of Georgetown Chrysler.

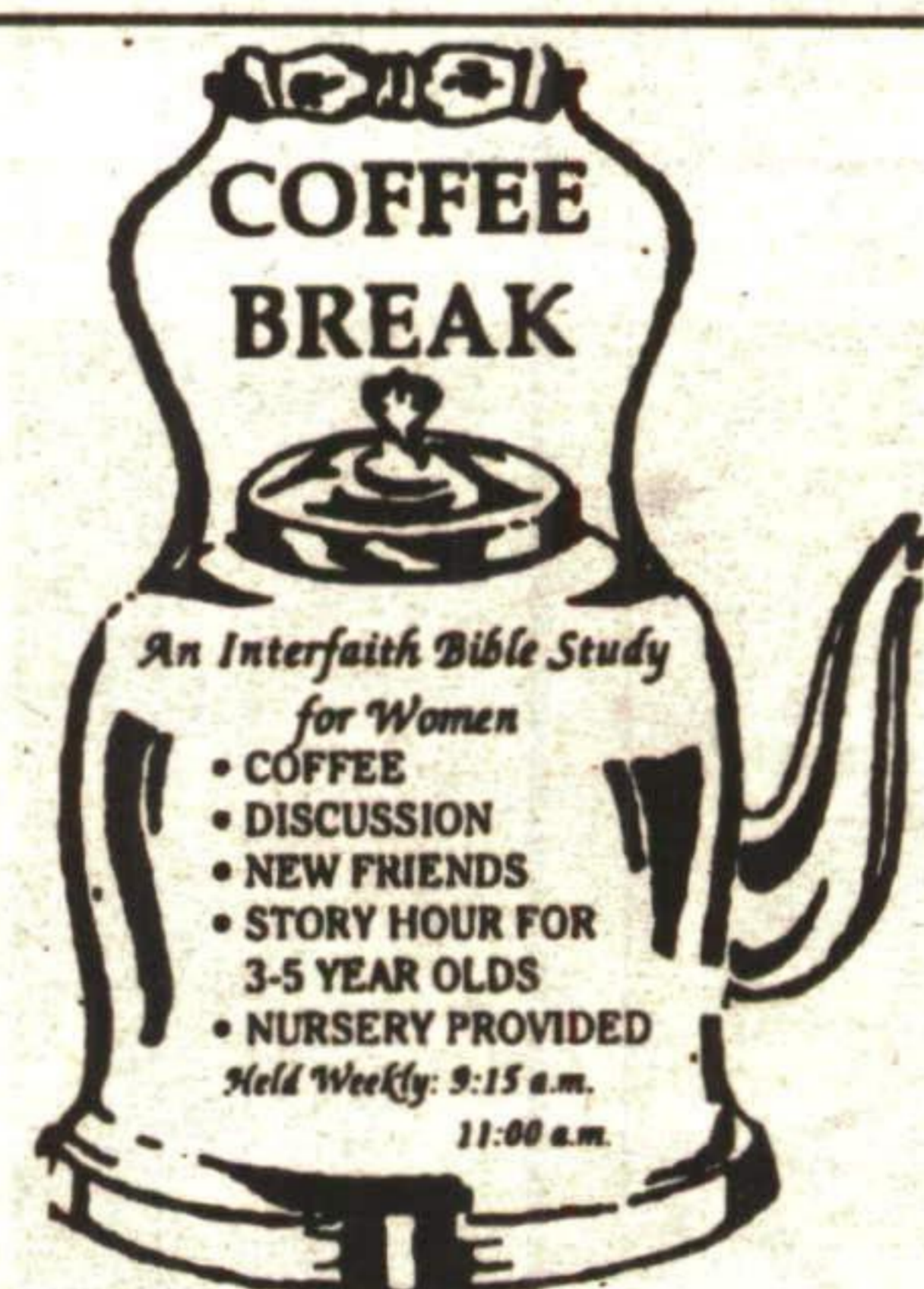
The complete golf and dinner/show package for 18 holes is just \$79.95 per person, and \$69.95 for 9 holes.
