## Get ready for the Oktoberfest Country Classic

Coming September 21-24, Oktoberfest is here again.

As children head back to school and fall quickly approaches, an enthusiastic group of volunteers are busily preparing for the second annual Oktoberfest Country Classic Horse Show at Halton Place in Halton Hills.

The show will attract Canada's top riders, including Ian Miller, Jay Hayes, Mac Cone and John Pearce (our Grand Prix Champion from the 1994 show).

This spectacular event will run from Thursday, September 21 to Sunday September 24 on the grounds of Halton Place, 15 Sideroad,



between Highway 25 and Trafalgar Road.

The second annual Oktoberfest Country Classic Horse Show will have attractions and events for children, spectators and horse enthusiasts alike.

A variety of Hunter and Jumper classes will be held each day. The

competition starts on Thursday September 21 with a different array of classes held each day, and culminates with the \$20,000 Altamira Grand Prix at 2 p.m. on Sunday September 24.

Returning for a second year is the ever-popular Gambler's Choice Winner Take-All class on Saturday afternoon. The Gambler's choice Winner Take-All is always a crowd favorite as each horse and rider combination choose their own course to achieve the highest points in a restricted time limit. The winner walks away with all the prize money, not having to share his good fortune with anyone else.
