An added bonus to Coffee Break is a highlight for kids called Story Hour. While mom is exploring the Bible, the kids are gathered for supervised Bible stories, singing, games, crafts and refreshments. An organized nursery for children up to two years old is also provided.

In an age where much of our leisure time is devoted to the betterment of our bodies it is refreshing to see organization like Coffee Break who also advocate the exercise of one's mind and soul.
