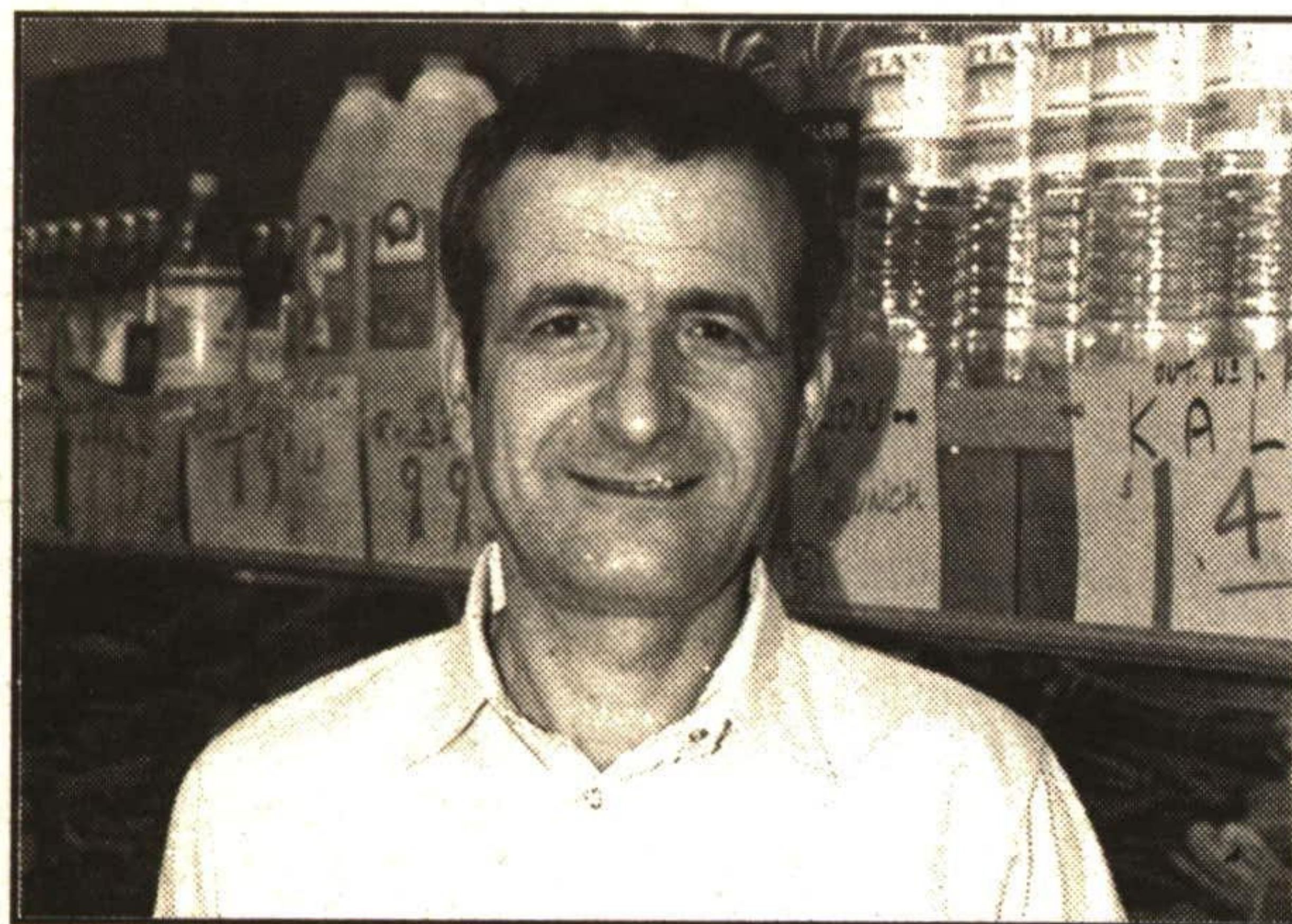
Marilyn's daughter Dorri owns and operates Total Feminine Look,

"We are the friendliest, happiest store in town," said Patrick. "We like to go out of our way to make it a pleasurable experience to shop here."

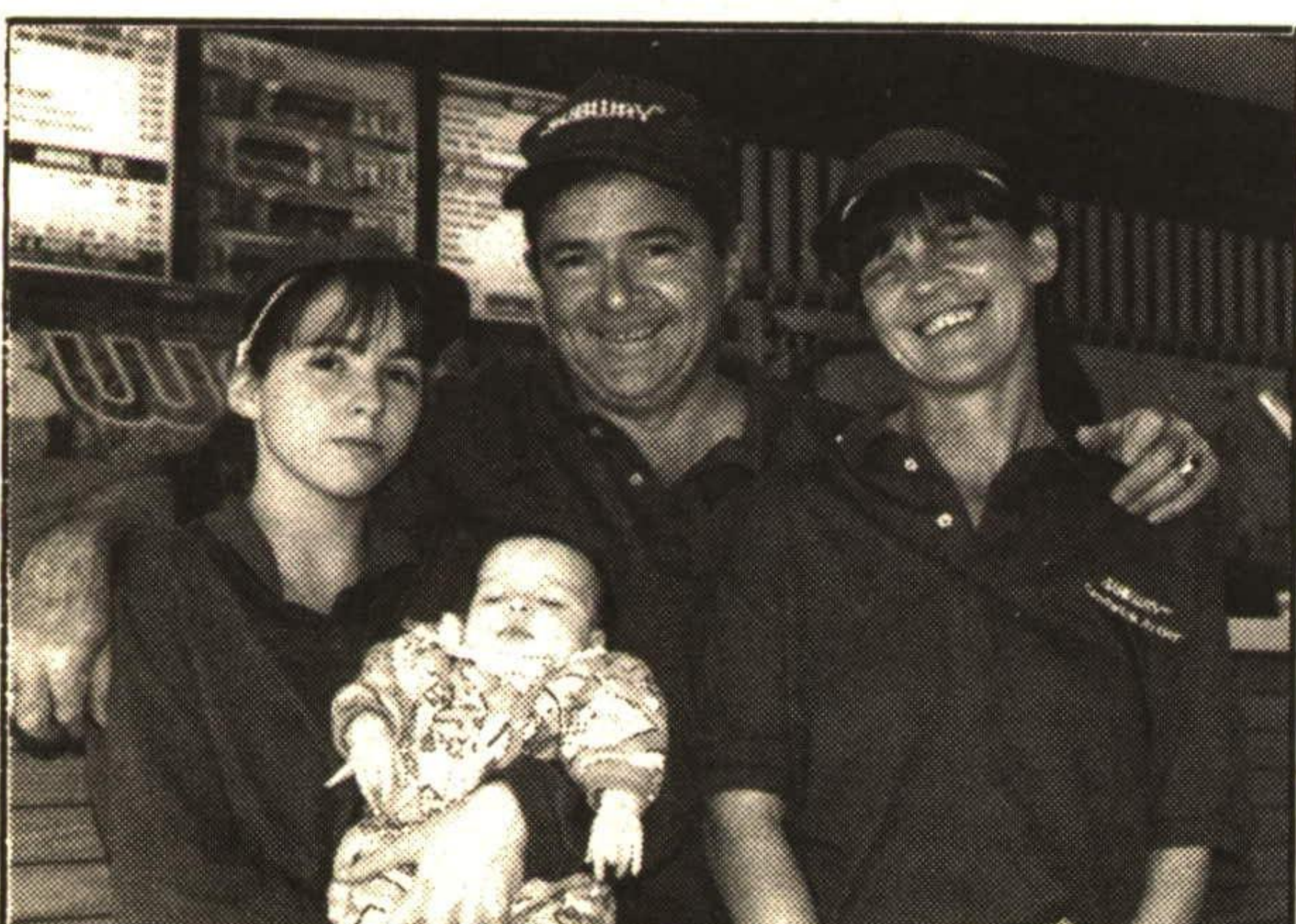
The three brothers, along with
