Our next step now is to move to mediation," said Erica Andrew, president of the Halton Women Teachers' Association. Ross McGuigan, president of the Halton District Ontario Public School Teachers' Association said, "Elementary teachers have been without a collective agreement for 14 months. The uncertainty has had an unsettling effect," he added.
