Dear Linda:

Can we afford Junior Kindergarten with all the more pressing needs of the education system in Ontario at the present time? I think not. What is the real purpose of Junior Kindergarten? It is to provide education and interaction amongst this age group or is it government-funded babysitting?

There are numerous venues to expose the very young to activities and social interaction amongst their peers available now in the private sector. The cost of which is next to nothing and

in many cases is free. Examples of these facilities in Georgetown are The Parent Child Centre, library programs, and there are multiple nursery schools as well.

On the subject of nursery schools, these facilities provide: qualified E.C.E Teachers (not a pre-requisite at JK), smaller teacher to student ratios, exclusively targeted to this age group.

If there is any question where more education dollars need to be spent, you should visit Georgetown District High School. This school on a daily basis is trying to educate over 1,400 students, with some class sizes as large as 37 students, shortages of science labs, shortages of computers and last year they

didn't even have enough chairs for students to sit in during class! These are the young people that will soon be going into college and universities or into the work world with a very uncertain future. If we are concerned about our society in its present disrepair we need to do a much better job at servicing our young adults needs immediately. Therefore, if there is any money to spend in our education system, this is where it should be spent.

Our province is in debt over \$90 billion, I think it is quite evident that money should not be spent on such a frivolous program to meet the needs of yet another special interest group.
