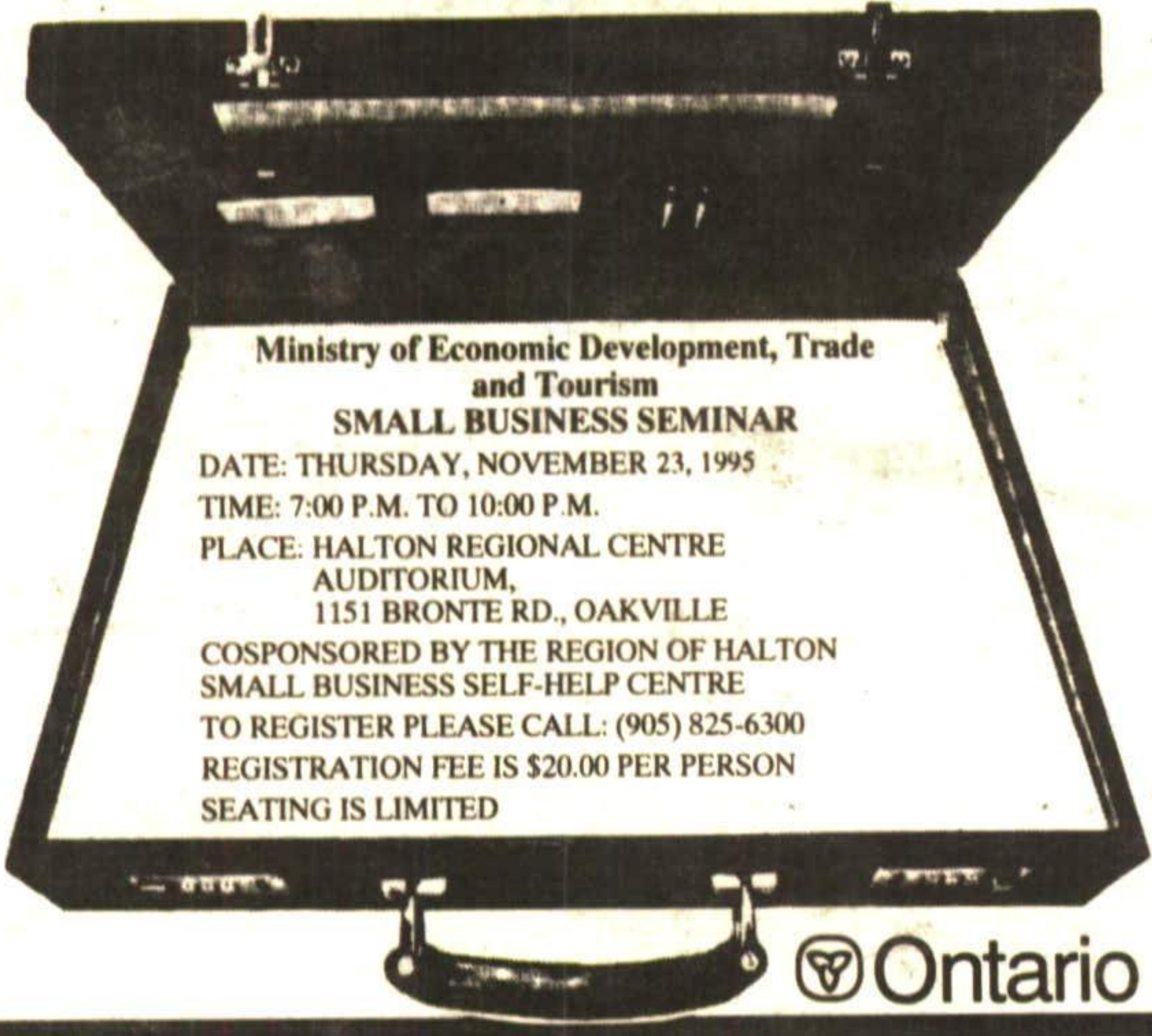

Police describe suspect

Someone has obtained a supply of power tools from an Acton store and Crime Stoppers wants to know who.

On Sunday, November 5, in the early evening, a cement block was thrown through the front door of Leathertown Lumber at 264 Main Street North. Saws, staplers, and nailers valued at almost \$3,000 were stolen.

Shortly before police were advised of the entry, a car was seen parked in front of the store's entrance. It was described as a mid-sized white four door car, in good condition, with black side molding.

A tall, slim male was seen jumping into the passenger side before it sped south on Main St.

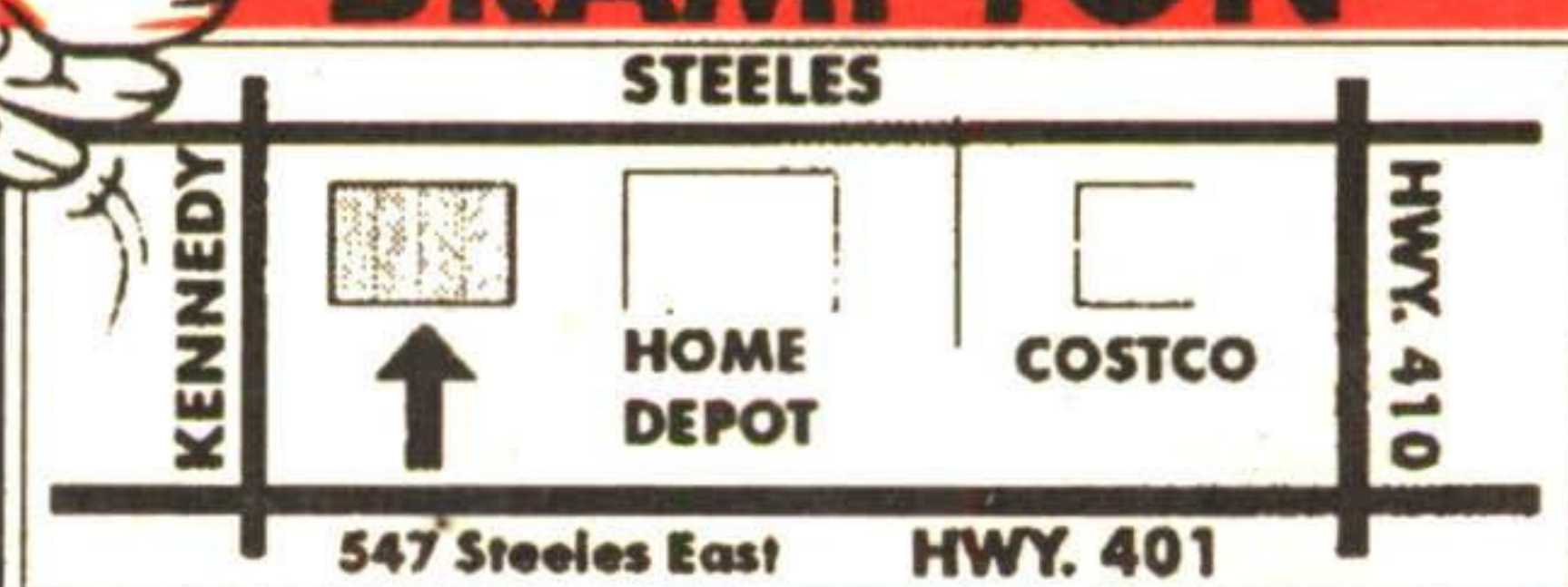
