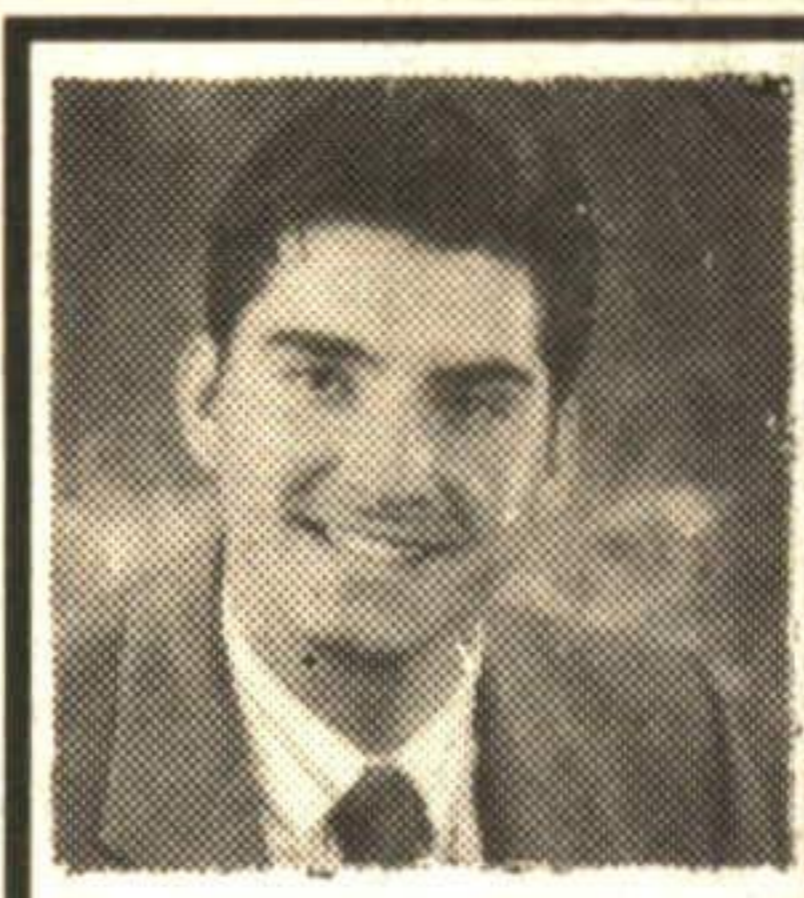
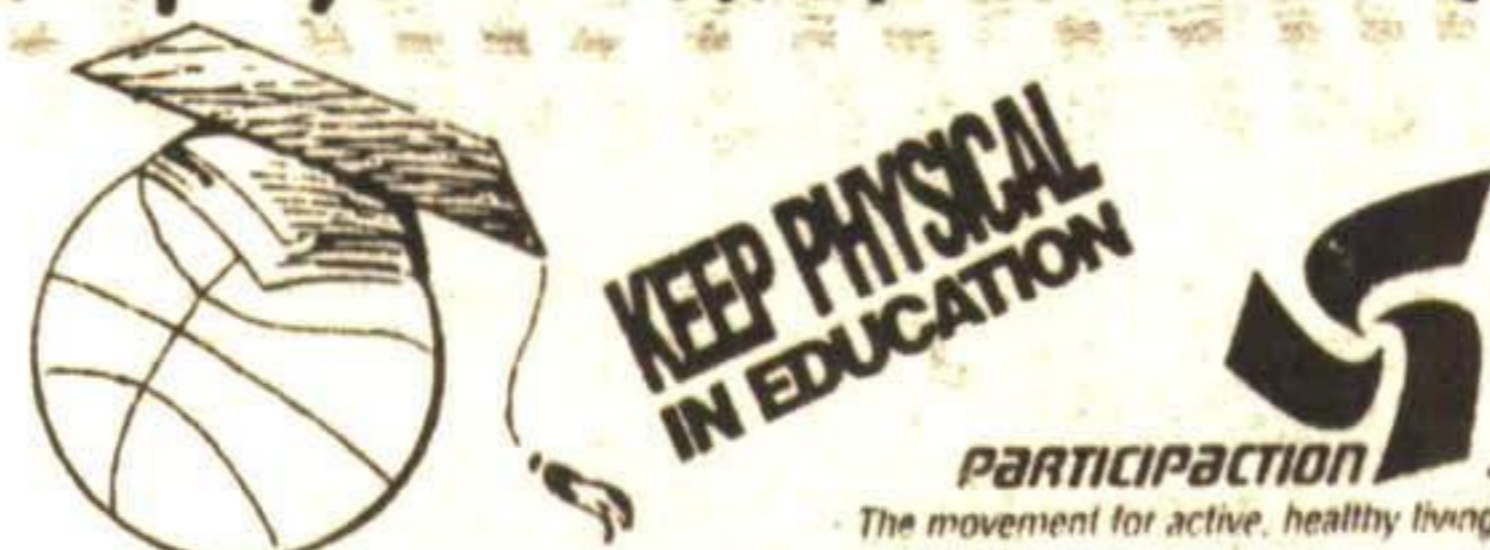

### BINAURAL AMPLIFICATION

Wearing one hearing aid may seem to be sufficient in a quiet situation, but when noise is present, one aid is usually not enough.

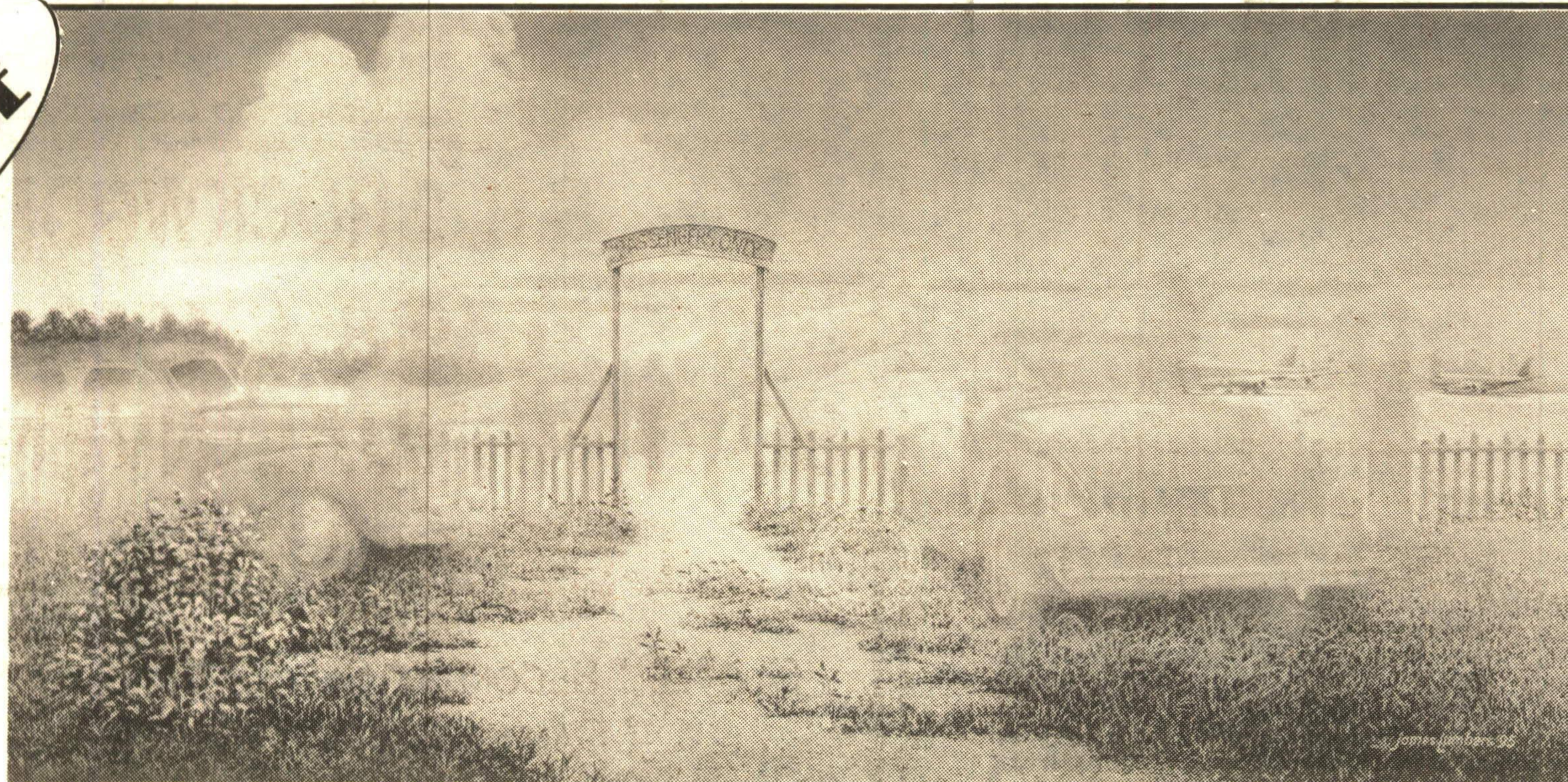
