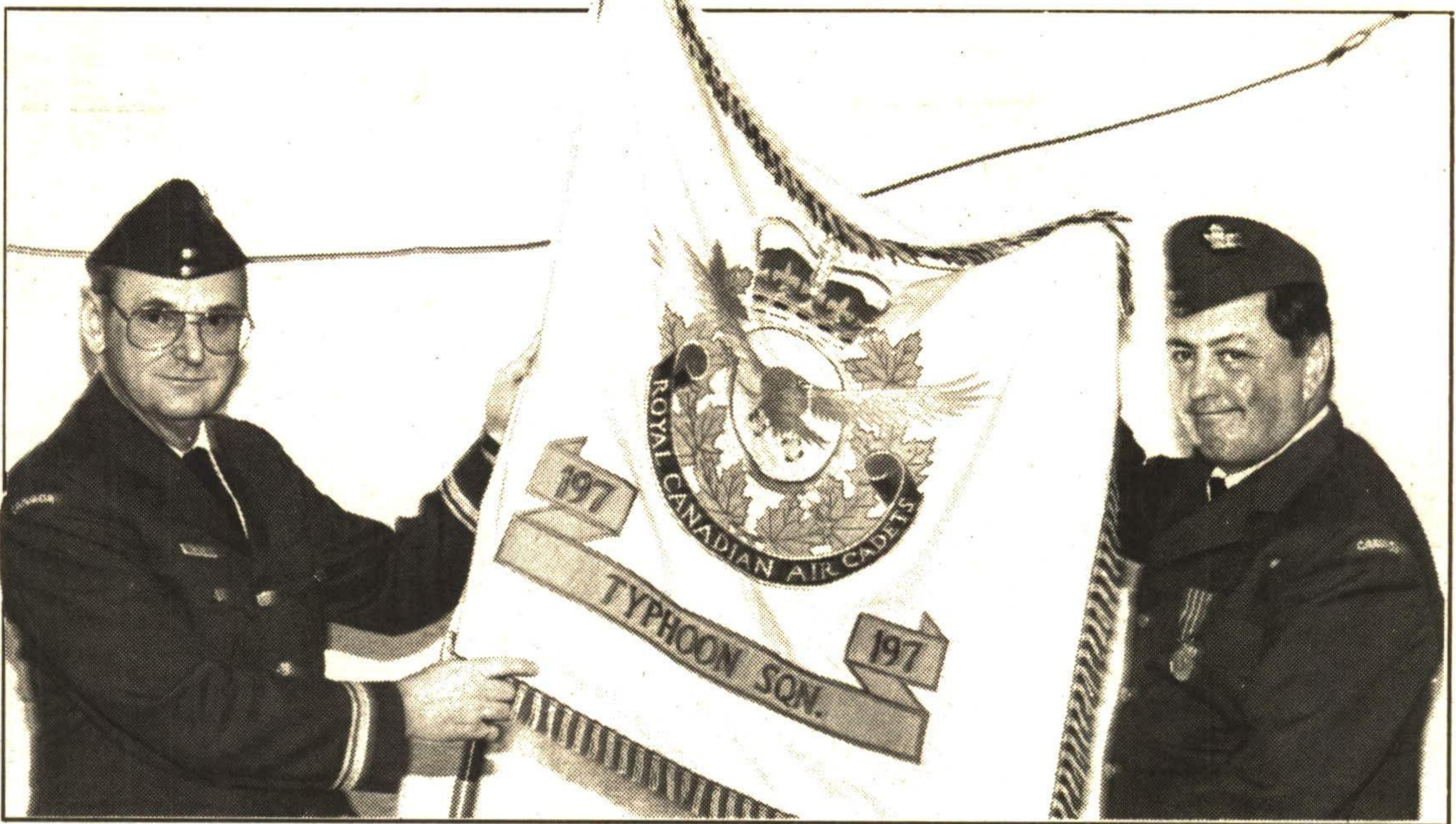

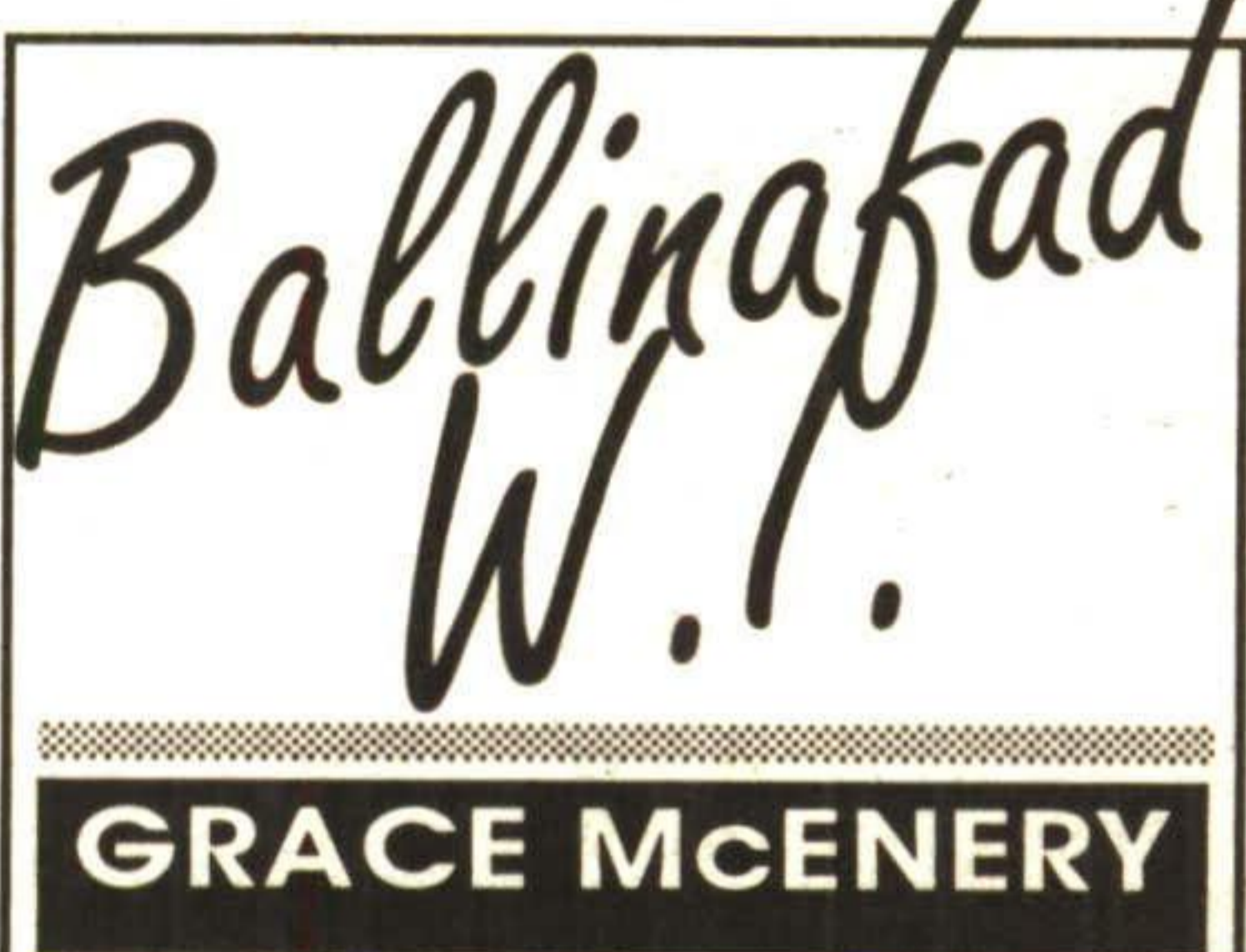

The next meeting will be January 10, at the home of Margaret Jamieson.



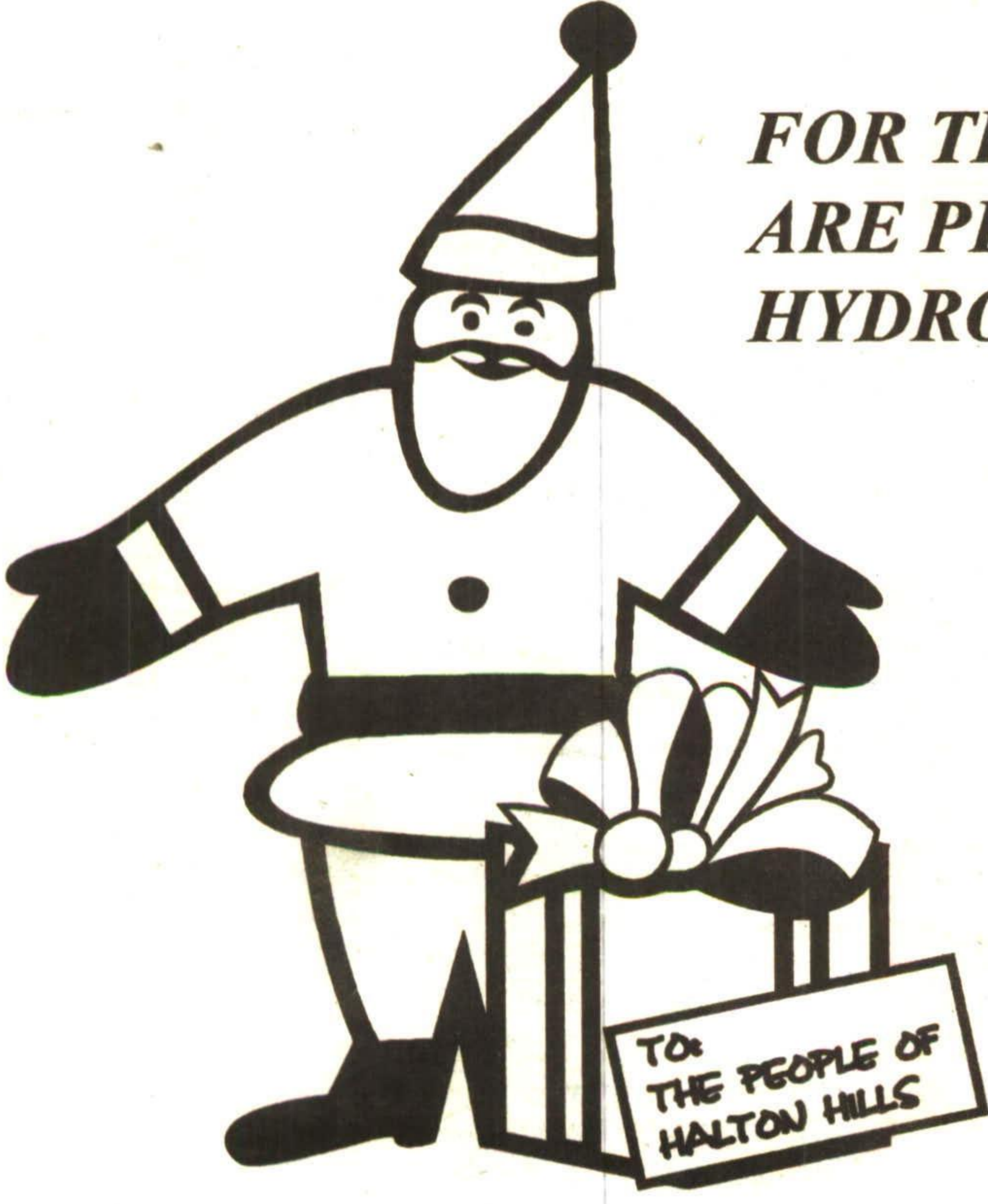
