# Local entries fall short in bid for tourney titles

Local hockey fans will have to wait for another year for a hometown champion at the annual Baantam Tournament.

The Georgetown Minor Bantams and the Halton Hurricanes were both stopped short in the division semifinals at the 36th Annual Georgetown International Bantam Tournament. Local teams have been shutout since Acton won the D title in 1988. Georgetown's last divisional title came in 1984.

The Minor Bantams went down to a 7-1 defeat at the hands of Huntsville in the D division semifinal while the Halton Hurricanes lost in the A semifinal 4-2 to the eventual grand champions, the Don Mills Flyers.

Huntsville entered its game against Georgetown having not surrendered a single goal in the tournament. The home side kept pace with in the opening period, allowing only Joey Reid's first of four goals, but Huntsville scored 43 seconds apart in the second to make it 3-0.

Georgetown finally ended the 112-minute shutout string of Huntsville's Ryan Nunn. A turnover at the Huntsville blueline sent Josh Travers and Sean Muscat in on a two-on-Nunn break. Travers kept the puck and slid a shot through Nunn's legs to cut the lead to 3-1.

Huntsville's added one goal to its lead before the period ended and continued to use its size to its advantage in the third, adding three more goals.

The Halton Hurricanes' run at a title was stopped by the eventual grand champions, the Don Mills Flyers. Robert MacLeod had

the only goal of the first as Halton took a 1-0 lead. Don Mills jumped in front 2-1 in the second but Brad Hooper scored with just five seconds left in the period to tie the game.

Don Mills got the eventual winner with 10:47 left in the third and added a late insurance marker.

The Minor Bantams finished the round robin with a 3-0 record. After opening with a 3-2 win over Oakville, Georgetown beat Nepean 3-1. Rod Heinz set up Josh Evans for the only goal of the first. Dan McBride upped the lead to 2-0 in the second. Jason Campbell and Chris Martyniuk drew assists. Nepean closed to within one but Tyler Pearce shut the opposition down in the third and McBride set up Martyniuk up for an insurance goal in the final minute.

Georgetown had to rally to keep its perfect record intact. It trailed Erin/Hillsburgh 2-0 with five minutes remaining in the game but struck for three goals, including Derek Mitchell's winner with just two seconds to play. Brent McClung started the

comeback at 4:46. Mike Rovere and Mick Zenil assisted on the goal. McClung and Travers set up Muscat for the tying goal with 2:33 to play.

Halton was also 3-0 in the round robin. A 6-2 win over the Kitchener Kings got the tournament started. Halton then blanked the Mississauga Rebels 4-0. Sean Robertson picked up the shutout. MacLeod, Hooper, Cory Broussard and Neal McDowell had the goals. Kyle Imerie had three assists while MacLeod had a pair. Jeff Chaisson and Gordon Willemse each had one assist.

Broussard had three goals in Halton's 4-1 win over Whitby. Broussard had a natural hat trick in the first period, scoring his goals within 5:28. Hooper made it 4-0 in the second. Chaisson had two assists while Hooper, MacLeod, Sam McLaughlin and Jamie Sweetland each had one.

Whitby's Mike Longo spoiled Dan Ellis' shutout bid early in the third.

The Georgetown Raiders Major Bantams didn't fair so well in the C Division. They lost all three of their games. After getting blanked by West Hill 4-0 in their opening game, Georgetown lost 6-1 to Mount Pearl. John Howell had the Raiders' only goal.

Georgetown lost its final game 8-3 to Nepean. Trailing 1-0, Jesse Ward scored from Judd Richardson and Ryan Booth to tie the game. Nepean went up 4-1 before Sean Hardcastle connected for Georgetown. Ian Cartwright and Brian Normore assisted. Cartwright had Georgetown's last goal midway through the third, which cut Nepean's lead to 7-3.
