Before expansion

Court rules UAL needs permits

The Ontario Court of Appeal recently ruled that United Aggregates Ltd. (UAL) will have to obtain a development permit the Niagara **Escarpment Commission** before it can proceed with expansion plans.

The issue was appealed to the court in relation to earlier judge's decision. UAL's expansion includes the proposed dewatering of the southern portion of the quarry.

The company has taken the position its activities are not regulated by the Escarpment Niagara Planning Development (NEPDA) because the quarry operation was established before the enactment of the act in 1973.

In the judgment it was UAL's concluded expansion considered a development within the meaning of the NEPDA.

It was also concluded a development permit under the Act was "required for prospective quarry activities and in particular the proposed dewatering."

Amendment is adopted.

In the judgment, signed by three Ontario Court of Appeal judges, it was stated "every creeping step to excavate new ground cannot be a development. On the other seems unreasonable to think that the legislature intended that the quarry continue in operation indefinitely, free of whatever controls the Act imposed."

"Phase II is much more than the incremental movement of machines over the property to excavate and process. It is a fresh stage in a long project," it was stated in the judgment.

The judgment also said UAL's proposed water discharge taking and could have a significant impact environment.

taking "The water would have an impact on groundwater levels, ground water contours and natural springs. proposed water discharge could have a serious effect on Black Creek Sixteen Mile Creek which adjoin the property."

UAL's appeal was dismissed with costs.




