From tee to green — Top holes in Halton Hills area....

Every golf course has its gems-those holes that challenge a golfer, the holes that with demanding terrain and the holes even after you finish you just want to stop and take another look at before moving

With that in mind, what if you put all those holes together in one course? Well, the seven local courses selected what they considered to be their best holes. What you would end up with is a 6,672-yard, par 72 course.

#1 Acton Meadows - Par 4, 375

yards

A hole that requires accuracy on your first shot of the day. Water lines the right side of the fairway, a creek guards the front of the green and a there's pond on the left side.

#4 Calerin - Par 5, 558 yards A pond in front of the tee requires a drive that will carry at least 150 yards. An undulating fairway leads to a tough green that will require a delicate touch when putting.

#5 North Halton - Par 4, 408

Teeing off on to a platform fairway, the second shot is hit from the elevated fairway into a green surrounded by traps with water on the left side.

#6 Calerin - Par 4, 392 yards

A tricky hole that doglegs to the right and is lined with trees on both sides. The right side is protected by a sand trap and a

pond and the left side of the green is guarded by a large maple. Chosen as one of the top 18 holes in the GTA by the Toronto Star.

#6 Erin Heights - Par 4, 380

This hole usually plays into the wind. A fairway bunker protects the dog leg to the left but by going wide you will have to watch for three bunkers on the right.

#7 Blue Springs - Par 4, 421

The approach will be the key on this hole, which has a slight dog leg to the right. From a downhill lie you will have to carry over water and bunkers to hit the undulating green, where

you're putting abilities will be tested.

#8 Blue Springs - Par 4, 378 yards

A hole that dares you and your driving ability. With a pond on an angle to the fairway, the more water you clear, the farther up the fairway you will be. Putting on the three-tiered green is also a big challenge. Chosen as one of the top 18 holes in the GTA by the Toronto Star.

#8 Hornby Towers - Par 4, 401 yards

A tough par four that requires a good drive and a long second to make the green.

#8 Acton Meadows - Par 3, 195

With water guarding the right

side it is advisable to aim left. Anything to the right will kick into the water.

IN- Par: 36, Yards 3,508

#10 Blue Springs - Par 4, 425 yards

Teeing off from an elevated green there is a slight dogleg to the right. The approach will be tricky as you will have to clear a small pond and a rock outcrop from a downhill lie to reach the elevated green.

#10 Georgetown - Par 4, 391



An unusual hole with a green that is cut into a hillside. The second shot is hit into a ravine over a river which protects the front of the green.


