

## Kathy Irvine is No. 6 in the world

On April 3, 15-year-old Georgetown resident Kathy Irvine, finished sixth in the 27th World Irish Dance Championship held in Dublin, Ireland.

Kathy was competing in the week long event (March 30-April 7) for the fourth time in her dancing career. Her sixth place finish this year in the under-16 age group was up from 15th last year.

"A competitor has to be in good physical condition and Kathy had been practising about 20 hours a week before the world's," said her father, Martin Irvine. "We're Irish and she's been doing it for about nine years."

Kathy competed against 84 other dancers in her age group. She did three dances, a reel, treble jig and a set dance. Competitors are marked by seven judges.

"She was awarded a piece of Belleek china as the best overseas dancer," said Martin Irvine.

Currently attending Bishop Reding High School, Kathy also dances for the Fearon School of Irish Dancing in Brampton. As well as dancing, Kathy plays soccer here in Georgetown.
